

## Solar Eclipse: January 5th 2019

### 15 degrees 25 minutes Capricorn

---

Solar eclipses occur with new moons, but their impact lasts longer, up to six months before and after. **We usually feel eclipses when they are triggered by a transit (moving) planet** conjunct (aligned with), square (hard aspect - 3 signs away), or opposite the point in the Zodiac the eclipse occurs in the months before or after. **For this eclipse, that would be a transit planet at 15 degrees 25 minutes of Capricorn (conjunct), Cancer (opposite), or Aries or Libra (square).**

We usually only count transit Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune, and Pluto to trigger since the Sun, Moon, Mercury, and Venus move so fast. The exception can be when transit Mercury or Venus are retrograde, but that's not the case for this eclipse.

Transit Jupiter is in Sagittarius, which is semisextile; transit Uranus is in Aries, which is square, but is at the end and won't cross over the eclipse point, and when he moves into Taurus, he'll be trine; and transit Neptune is in Pisces, which is sextile. That leaves transit Saturn and Mars. **Transit Saturn in Capricorn conjuncts the eclipse point February 5th, and transit Mars in squares the eclipse point January 23rd in Aries, and opposes the eclipse point June 8th in Cancer, so these are your triggers.**

You can experience a personal trigger with your progressed chart. Your progressed chart adds one day to your date of birth for every year you've been alive to create a new chart reflecting your maturation and growth. **If any of your progressed planets comes to 15 degrees 25 minutes Capricorn, Cancer, Aries, or Libra in the 6 months before/after, you can experience a personal trigger.** Personal triggers are often more important and prominent for you than a trigger by a transit planet. So if you have that happening, pay close attention to it!

With this eclipse occurring in Capricorn, the general impact for us all can focus on **goals, ambitions, and direction**. We can focus on what we want to achieve and succeed with, what we want to accomplish in our lives, the goals we want to work on long-term, the direction our lives are going in, and the long-term plans we need to work on creating. We can be practical, disciplined, and responsible.

**Personally, it's all about what the eclipse is doing to your own chart.**

**First assess the house the eclipse will occur in.** Think about what the house rules and how this can impact you. Solar eclipses are times of increased energy, enthusiasm, and new beginnings, and with the Capricorn energy, this can play out with our goals and ambitions, and what we're striving for in life. This can be funnelled to the areas of life ruled by the house the eclipse occurs in. The houses are:

1st house of the self, beginnings

2nd house of money, self-esteem, values

3rd house of the mind, learning, communication, close environment

4th house of home and family, emotions, internal foundation

5th house of love, dating, children, hobbies

6th house of work, health, daily life, pets

7th house of relationships

8th house of transformations, other people's money

9th house of expansion, higher education, travel, law

10th house of career, goals, life path, elders, public image

11th house of friends, hopes, dreams, charity

12th house of endings, subconscious mind, karma, your undoing

If you have a house cusp between 10 degrees 25 minutes - 20 degrees 25 minutes Capricorn, the eclipse will be conjunct the house cusp, which can **elevate** the impact on you house-wise.

Note: If you don't have a house cusp with Capricorn on it, that means the eclipse is intercepted in the house with Sagittarius on the cusp.

Interceptions are contained energy, and that can show this eclipse plays out in a more **subconscious** way.

Once you've gotten through all of that, you can assess the aspects the eclipse will make to your natal planets. The aspects for this eclipse are:

Conjunction: 10 degrees 25 minutes - 20 degrees 25 minutes Capricorn

Semisextile: 13 degrees 25 minutes - 17 degrees 25 minutes Sagittarius or Aquarius

Sextile: 10 degrees 25 minutes - 20 degrees 25 minutes Scorpio or Pisces

Square: 10 degrees 25 minutes - 20 degrees 25 minutes Aries or Libra

Trine: 10 degrees 25 minutes - 20 degrees 25 minutes Taurus or Virgo

Quincunx: 13 degrees 25 minutes - 17 degrees 25 minutes Gemini or Leo

Opposition: 10 degrees 25 minutes - 20 degrees 25 minutes Cancer

You'll generally focus most on any conjunctions as they **amplify** energy, so pay close attention to those. Semisextiles, sextiles, and trines are positive (beneficial) aspects, so aspects to those planets will be largely **helpful**. Squares, oppositions, and quincunxes are hard (difficult) aspects, so aspects to those planets will be largely **challenging**.

The planets are:

Sun (rules the self)

Moon (rules emotions)

Mercury (rules the mind)

Venus (rules relationships & money)

Mars (rules energy & drive)

Jupiter (rules expansion, exploration, new experiences)

Saturn (rules goals, ambitions, responsibilities)

Uranus (rules change, independence, the unconventional)

Neptune (rules your subconscious, spirituality)

Pluto (rules power, control, transformations)

## Lunar Eclipse: January 21st 2019

### 0 degrees 51 minutes Leo

---

Lunar eclipses occur with full moons, but their impact lasts longer, up to six months before and after. **We usually feel eclipses when they are triggered by a transit (moving) planet** conjunct (aligned with), square (hard aspect - 3 signs away), or opposite the point in the Zodiac the eclipse occurs in the months before or after. **For this eclipse, that would be a transit planet at 0 degrees 51 minutes of Leo (conjunct), Aquarius (opposite), or Taurus or Scorpio (square).**

Transit Jupiter is in Sagittarius, which is trine; transit Saturn and Pluto are in Capricorn, which is quincunx; transit Neptune is in Pisces, which is also quincunx; so that leaves transit Mars and Uranus. **Transit Uranus moves back into Taurus in 2019 in March, which is square, and triggers this eclipse March 24th; Mars will square in Taurus on February 15th.**

You can experience a personal trigger with your progressed chart. **If any of your progressed planets comes to 0 degrees 51 minutes Leo, Aquarius, Taurus, or Scorpio in the 6 months before/after, you can experience a personal trigger.**

With this eclipse occurring in Leo, the general impact for us all can focus on **love, creativity, and drama**. We can focus on getting serious about

what we love and feel connected to, feel more inspired which makes us feel stronger, or crave more attention which makes us more dramatic.

**Personally, it's all about what the eclipse is doing to your own chart.**

**First assess the house the eclipse will occur in.** Think about what the house rules and how this can impact you. Lunar eclipses are times of endings, heightened emotions, and culminations, and with the Leo energy, this can play out with the things or people we love and creative energy that's funnelled to the areas of life ruled by the house the eclipse occurs in.

If you have a house cusp between 0 degrees 0 minutes and 5 degrees 51 minutes Leo, the eclipse will be conjunct the house cusp, which can **elevate** the impact on you house-wise.

Remember: If you don't have a house cusp with Leo on it, that means the eclipse is intercepted in the house with Cancer on the cusp. Interceptions are contained energy, and that can show this eclipse plays out in a more **subconscious** way.

Once you've gotten through all of that, you can assess the aspects the eclipse will make to your natal planets. The aspects for this eclipse are:

Conjunction: 0 degrees 0 minutes - 5 degrees 51 minutes Leo

Semisextile: 0 degrees 0 minutes - 2 degrees 51 minutes Cancer or Virgo

Sextile: 0 degrees 0 minutes - 5 degrees 51 minutes Gemini or Libra

Square: 0 degrees 0 minutes - 5 degrees 51 minutes Taurus or Scorpio

Trine: 0 degrees 0 minutes - 5 degrees 51 minutes Aries or Sagittarius

Quincunx: 0 degrees 0 minutes - 2 degrees 51 minutes Capricorn or Pisces

Opposition: 0 degrees 0 minutes - 5 degrees 51 minutes Aquarius

Note: Since this eclipse is very early in Leo, it may also make out-of-sign aspects (as if it were in the previous sign, Cancer). **Out-of-sign aspects usually aren't as strong, but can still be assessed.** The out-of-sign aspects made for this eclipse are:

Conjunction: 25 degrees 51 minutes - 29 degrees 59 minutes Cancer

Semisextile: 28 degrees 51 minutes - 29 degrees 59 minutes Gemini or Leo

Sextile: 25 degrees 51 minutes - 29 degrees 59 minutes Taurus or Virgo

Square: 25 degrees 51 minutes - 29 degrees 59 minutes Aries or Libra

Trine: 25 degrees 51 minutes - 29 degrees 59 minutes Scorpio or Pisces

Quincunx: 28 degrees 51 minutes - 29 degrees 59 minutes Sagittarius or Aquarius

Opposition: 25 degrees 51 minutes - 29 degrees 59 minutes Capricorn

You'll generally focus most on any conjunctions as they **amplify** energy, so pay close attention to those. Semisextiles, sextiles, and trines are positive (beneficial) aspects, so aspects to those planets will be largely **helpful**. Squares, oppositions, and quincunxes are hard (difficult) aspects, so aspects to those planets will be largely **challenging**.

## Solar Eclipse: July 2nd 2019

### 10 degrees 27 minutes Cancer

---

Solar eclipses occur with new moons, but their impact lasts longer, up to six months before and after. **We usually feel eclipses when they are triggered by a transit (moving) planet** conjunct (aligned with), square (hard aspect - 3 signs away), or opposite the point in the Zodiac the eclipse occurs in the months before or after. **For this eclipse, that would be a transit planet at 10 degrees 37 minutes of Cancer (conjunct), Capricorn (opposite), or Aries or Libra (square).**

We usually only count transit Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune, and Pluto to trigger since the Sun, Moon, Mercury, and Venus move so fast. The exception can be when transit Mercury or Venus are retrograde, but that's not the case for this eclipse.

Transit Jupiter is in Sagittarius, which is quincunx; transit Uranus is in Taurus, which is sextile; transit Neptune is in Pisces, which is trine; and transit Saturn and Pluto are in Capricorn, which is opposite, but don't go over the eclipse point. That leaves transit Mars. **Transit Mars triggers the eclipse June 1st and October 20th.**

You can experience a personal trigger with your progressed chart. **If any of your progressed planets comes to 10 degrees 37 minutes Cancer,**

**Capricorn, Aries, or Libra in the 6 months before/after, you can experience a personal trigger.**

With this eclipse occurring in Cancer, the general impact for us all can focus on **the home/family, our emotions, and foundations**. We can focus on connecting to our homes and families, making improvements in those connections, strengthening ourselves emotionally, focusing on positive emotions, and expanding support systems. We can be comforting and nurturing, and build solid foundations that can sustain for generations.

**Personally, it's all about what the eclipse is doing to your own chart.**

**First assess the house the eclipse will occur in.** Think about what the house rules and how this can impact you. Solar eclipses are times of increased energy, enthusiasm, and new beginnings, and with the Cancer energy, this can play out with our emotions, home/family lives, and foundations. This can be funnelled to the areas of life ruled by the house the eclipse occurs in.

If you have a house cusp between 5 degrees 37 minutes - 15 degrees 37 minutes Cancer, the eclipse will be conjunct the house cusp, which can **elevate** the impact on you house-wise.

Note: If you don't have a house cusp with Cancer on it, that means the eclipse is intercepted in the house with Gemini on the cusp.

Interceptions are contained energy, and that can show this eclipse plays out in a more **subconscious** way.

Once you've gotten through all of that, you can assess the aspects the eclipse will make to your natal planets. The aspects for this eclipse are:

Conjunction: 5 degrees 37 minutes - 15 degrees 37 minutes Cancer

Semisextile: 8 degrees 37 minutes - 12 degrees 37 minutes Gemini or Leo

Sextile: 5 degrees 37 minutes - 15 degrees 37 minutes Taurus or Virgo

Square: 5 degrees 37 minutes - 15 degrees 37 minutes Aries or Libra

Trine: 5 degrees 37 minutes - 15 degrees 37 minutes Scorpio or Pisces

Quincunx: 8 degrees 37 minutes - 12 degrees 37 minutes Sagittarius or Aquarius

Opposition: 5 degrees 37 minutes - 15 degrees 37 minutes Capricorn

You'll generally focus most on any conjunctions as they **amplify** energy, so pay close attention to those. Semisextiles, sextiles, and trines are positive (beneficial) aspects, so aspects to those planets will be largely **helpful**. Squares, oppositions, and quincunxes are hard (difficult) aspects, so aspects to those planets will be largely **challenging**.

## Lunar Eclipse: July 16th 2019

### 24 degrees 4 minutes Capricorn

---

Lunar eclipses occur with full moons, but their impact lasts longer, up to six months before and after. **We usually feel eclipses when they are triggered by a transit (moving) planet** conjunct (aligned with), square (hard aspect - 3 signs away), or opposite the point in the Zodiac the eclipse occurs in the months before or after. **For this eclipse, that would be a transit planet at 24 degrees 4 minutes of Capricorn (conjunct), Cancer (opposite), or Aries or Libra (square).**

Transit Jupiter is in Sagittarius, which is semisextile; transit Saturn and Pluto are in Capricorn, but won't come to the eclipse point in 2019; transit Neptune is in Pisces, which is sextile; transit Uranus is in Taurus, which is trine; so that leaves transit Mars. **Transit Mars triggers this eclipse February 5th, June 22nd, and November 10th.**

You can experience a personal trigger with your progressed chart. **If any of your progressed planets comes to 24 degrees 4 minutes Capricorn, Cancer, Aries, or Libra in the 6 months before/after, you can experience a personal trigger.**

With this eclipse occurring in Capricorn, the general impact for us all can focus on **our goals, ambitions, and direction.** We can focus on getting

serious about our goals and ambitions, making progress with the goals we've worked hard at and been smart with, and take on more responsibilities.

**Personally, it's all about what the eclipse is doing to your own chart.**

**First assess the house the eclipse will occur in.** Think about what the house rules and how this can impact you. Lunar eclipses are times of endings, heightened emotions, and culminations, and with the Capricorn energy, this can play out with our goals and direction, and this can be funnelled to the areas of life ruled by the house the eclipse occurs in.

If you have a house cusp between 19 degrees 4 minutes and 29 degrees 4 minutes Capricorn, the eclipse will be conjunct the house cusp, which can **elevate** the impact on you house-wise.

Remember: If you don't have a house cusp with Capricorn on it, that means the eclipse is intercepted in the house with Sagittarius on the cusp. Interceptions are contained energy, and that can show this eclipse plays out in a more **subconscious** way.

Once you've gotten through all of that, you can assess the aspects the eclipse will make to your natal planets. The aspects for this eclipse are:

Conjunction: 19 degrees 4 minutes - 29 degrees 4 minutes Capricorn

Semisextile: 22 degrees 4 minutes - 26 degrees 4 minutes Sagittarius or Aquarius

Sextile: 19 degrees 4 minutes - 29 degrees 4 minutes Scorpio or Pisces

Square: 19 degrees 4 minutes - 29 degrees 4 minutes Aries or Libra

Trine: 19 degrees 4 minutes - 29 degrees 4 minutes Taurus or Virgo

Quincunx: 24 degrees 4 minutes - 26 degrees 4 minutes Gemini or Leo

Opposition: 19 degrees 4 minutes - 29 degrees 4 minutes Cancer

You'll generally focus most on any conjunctions as they **amplify** energy, so pay close attention to those. Semisextiles, sextiles, and trines are positive (beneficial) aspects, so aspects to those planets will be largely **helpful**. Squares, oppositions, and quincunxes are hard (difficult) aspects, so aspects to those planets will be largely **challenging**.

## **July 16th 2019 Capricorn Lunar Eclipse & Your Chart:**

## Solar Eclipse: December 26th 2019

### 4 degrees 6 minutes Capricorn

---

Solar eclipses occur with new moons, but their impact lasts longer, up to six months before and after. **We usually feel eclipses when they are triggered by a transit (moving) planet** conjunct (aligned with), square (hard aspect - 3 signs away), or opposite the point in the Zodiac the eclipse occurs in the months before or after. **For this eclipse, that would be a transit planet at 4 degrees 6 minutes of Capricorn (conjunct), Cancer (opposite), or Aries or Libra (square).**

Transit Neptune is in Pisces, which is sextile, transit Uranus is in Taurus, which is trine; and transit Saturn and Pluto are both in Capricorn, but won't cross the eclipse point. That leaves transit Jupiter, who will newly be in Capricorn when this eclipse occurs, and Mars. **Transit Jupiter in Capricorn triggers this eclipse December 20th, and transit Mars in Libra triggers the eclipse October 10th, and in Capricorn February 22nd (of 2020).**

You can experience a personal trigger with your progressed chart. **If any of your progressed planets comes to 4 degrees 6 minutes Capricorn, Cancer, Aries, or Libra in the 6 months before/after, you can experience a personal trigger.**

With this eclipse occurring in Capricorn, the general impact for us all can focus on **goals, ambitions, and direction**. We can focus on what we want to achieve and succeed with, what we want to accomplish in our lives, the goals we want to work on long-term, the direction our lives are going in, and the long-term plans we need to work on creating. We can be practical, disciplined, and responsible.

**Personally, it's all about what the eclipse is doing to your own chart.**

**First assess the house the eclipse will occur in.** Think about what the house rules and how this can impact you. Once you've gotten through all of that, you can assess the aspects the eclipse will make to your natal planets. The aspects for this eclipse are:

Conjunction: 0 degrees 0 minutes - 9 degrees 6 minutes Capricorn

Semisextile: 2 degrees 6 minutes - 6 degrees 6 minutes Sagittarius or Aquarius

Sextile: 0 degrees 0 minutes - 9 degrees 6 minutes Scorpio or Pisces

Square: 0 degrees 0 minutes - 9 degrees 6 minutes Aries or Libra

Trine: 0 degrees 0 minutes - 9 degrees 6 minutes Taurus or Virgo

Quincunx: 2 degrees 6 minutes - 6 degrees 6 minutes Gemini or Leo

Opposition: 0 degrees 0 minutes - 9 degrees 6 minutes Cancer

Note: Since this eclipse is fairly early in Capricorn, it may make out-of-sign aspects (as if it were in previous sign, Sagittarius), but only for the major aspects (so not for semisextiles and quincunxes), and only at 29 degrees, so **the effect may be even more subtle than usual for an out-of-sign aspect, if it's felt at all.** Just in case, the out-of-sign aspects are:

Conjunction: 29 degrees 6 minutes - 59 minutes Sagittarius

Sextile: 29 degrees 6 minutes - 59 minutes Libra or Aquarius

Square: 29 degrees 6 minutes - 59 minutes Virgo or Pisces

Trine: 29 degrees 6 minutes - 59 minutes Aries or Leo

Opposition: 29 degrees 6 minutes - 59 minutes Gemini
