Unit 1: North Node

What are the Lunar Nodes? The Lunar Nodes are the points in the Moon's orbit where the Moon crosses the ecliptic. There are two Lunar Nodes, a North Node and a South Node, and they exactly oppose one another in the Zodiac. The Lunar Nodes are karmic and spiritual in nature.

The South Node is the past, it's what you've already learned in past lives or early in this life, which makes it comfortable and familiar. This can make it easy to fall back on your South Node in times of emotional stress and upset, so it can become baggage, bad habits, and emotional crutches. The South Node often shows areas where we need to let go of those things that aren't serving us anymore.

The North Node is the future. The North Node shows your potential in this life, and how to find ultimate happiness, satisfaction, and contentment. It's what you can grow into, your reward for evolving and letting go. But it's unfamiliar and uncomfortable, so we tend to stay away from the energy for a while. This means you have to make a more conscious choice with your North Node, while your South Node tends to operate more subconsciously.

We're going to focus on the North Node. Make the conscious choice! It can feel completely uncomfortable, even scary, when you do, but it's

absolutely worth it. This is where you can find your best self, so don't run away from it. Force yourself to be more like your North Node for a little while, and see how that changes things in your life.

North Node interpretations will be given for the signs, and each sign will have points depending on what house it falls in your natal chart. At the end, you'll also find info about natal planets in your North Node sign.

Bonus tip: Focus on the natural planetary ruler for your North Node (sign, location, aspects) for additional info about your North Node. The ruler usually ties into the energy, showing how easy/difficult it may be, and more areas it may be directed. The natural planetary rulers for the signs are:

Aries: Mars

Taurus, Libra: Venus

Gemini, Virgo: Mercury

Cancer: Moon

Leo: Sun

Scorpio: Pluto

Sagittarius: Jupiter

Capricorn: Saturn

Aquarius: Uranus

Pisces: Neptune

Also assess if your North Node is at a critical or anaretic degree. These are special degrees of critical energy that may mean you have an extra block to work through in order to use your nodes properly, so that may be something to keep in mind. Anaretic is 29 degrees of any sign, the very last degree; the critical degrees are:

0, 13, and 26 degrees of Aries, Cancer, Libra, Capricorn

8-9 and 21-22 degrees of Taurus, Leo, Scorpio, Aquarius

4 and 17 degrees of Gemini, Virgo, Sagittarius, Pisces

If the natural planetary ruler of your North Node is critical or anaretic, that can also show a block/issue.

If your North Node is intercepted, this can show manifesting your nodes in a more subconscious way, and needing to work through a subconscious block in order to use the energy consciously. Intercepted means that the sign your North Node is located in isn't on any of your house cusps, so the energy is contained within the house that has the previous sign on the cusp.

These are challenges that you usually need to address before you can access your North Node, so make sure to address them!

Make note: What sign and house is your North Node in? Do you have any natal planets in your North Node sign?

North Node in the Signs/Houses

North Node in Aries

Focus on YOU! Aries North Node is all about you. Others may be selfish, but you haven't learned that, so force yourself to be more "selfish". It's not really selfish to make yourself more of a priority, anyway, so stop telling yourself that! Celebrate yourself, your own talents, ideas, and work. Give your needs attention, and make sure you're not going without.

Focus on knowing yourself better, and really understanding your motivations, your desires, your needs, your thoughts and opinions. Everything about you! Understanding yourself better helps you to have more confidence, which is something you need. Let go of insecurity and learn more about yourself to develop better confidence. Give yourself the respect you deserve, and others will follow.

Aries is the first sign, so you're meant to be the leader, the trailblazer, the pioneer. No one's done it before? That's probably your cue to go for it! Don't let the naysayers hold you back. You don't need their approval to make things happen. You have the fire already within you. No sign is more fiery than Aries! Developing assertiveness is something you need. Push yourself through fear to the other side.

One more thing - all of the fire signs want to enjoy life, which includes Aries. Don't let the desire to keep the peace and please everyone else stop you from enjoying your life. That is NOT what you're meant to do! If it upsets others, so be it; that may just be a sign you need to surround yourself with better people who support you in your journey toward happiness, not that you have to keep yourself from joy. Do the things that make you laugh, smile, and not worry so much about other people.

- Make yourself a priority
- Spend more time understanding yourself better
- Develop confidence and assertiveness

Aries North Node in the houses:

1st house: naturally connects to Aries so amplifies need to pursue Aries energy, also brings a little luck once you're manifesting the energy properly

2nd house: be assertive with your values, take charge financially (self-reliant, make your own money), confidence is even more important and needs to be developed

3rd house: pursue your ideas and plans, be assertive and confident in your mental abilities

4th house: be the leader of your family (one you're born into or one you create), secure your internal foundation, harness emotional energy to your advantage

5th house: connect with your heart and prioritize love and joy, pursue creative ventures

6th house: lead/trailblazer with your work, may need to work alone, take control in daily life, take control with health (exercise!)

7th house: is polar opposite to Aries so may volley between feeling comfortable with focus on self to wanting to solely focus on others; may need to better integrate and balance the self with others

8th house: super strong, willful, take control of yourself and life, embrace your personal power, take control of transformations

9th house: be adventurous, daring and bold, take charge with expansion in your life and pursue opportunities with energy and zeal

10th house: take charge with your goals, aim high, embrace ambition, manage responsibilities

11th house: pursue your dreams for the future, embrace what makes you different, be independent and innovative, stand out from the crowd

12th house: be a spiritual leader, focus on spiritual pursuits, be quietly assertive or lead in the background

North Node in Taurus

Relax! Taurus North Nodes are meant to take a step back from it all and learn how to relax. No need to rush, no need to give in to extremes. Learn to be calm, steady, focused, reliable. Your life is meant to be stable and secure. No need to get heated. Just take it easy!

Focus on grounding yourself. Be still and in the present moment. It's the only moment you're guaranteed! Be one with your physical body and with the physical world. Taurus is a very physical earth sign, and governs the senses. Eat rich foods, wear seductive scents, listen to your favorite music, surround yourself with what you feel is beautiful. Yours is a life meant to be lived in beauty and comfort.

Since this sign is so physical, it also governs money and material possessions. Taurus North Node has to learn to keep more for itself instead of giving everything away. This doesn't mean you have to hoard everything for yourself (you're not a miser!). It means embracing an abundant life in every way, so you have more than enough for yourself and for others.

Learn what your values are. Your own values, not those you grew up with, not the ones of everyone around you, but your own. What do you place value in? What is worthy of your time and attention? And don't

forget self-worth, self-confidence, and self-respect. Don't look externally for validation - look within yourself.

- Relax and learn to be calm
- Ground yourself and live in the moment
- Connect with the physical world
- Learn your values

Taurus North Node in the houses:

1st house: developing confidence is more important here, and forming a more stable, grounded personality and approach to life

2nd house: naturally connects to Taurus so amplifies the energy, brings extra focus to being grounded and abundant

3rd house: steady your mind and ground your thoughts, make your ideas tangible

4th house: create an abundant home/family life, ground emotional energy so you're calmer and more in control of yourself

5th house: steadily pursue creative ventures that allow you to create something of beauty, be in the moment when experiencing joy

6th house: be practical with work and focus on the work you can stick with and create abundance with, learning to relax can help with stress and health

7th house: focus on stable relationships with reliable people, help others to create abundance in their lives, grounding can help you feel balanced

8th house: is polar opposite to Taurus so may volley between the two energies, may need to integrate and balance calming and grounding with intensity and passion

9th house: be quietly adventurous, ground yourself through expansion, focus on your beliefs and values

10th house: be highly ambitious but practical, success comes after lots of time and steady effort but sticks

11th house: embracing your individuality helps to calm and ground you, focus on stable friends, steadily pursue your dreams

12th house: ground yourself spiritually, embrace your inner earth god/dess, can be the calming force behind the scenes

North Node in Gemini

Open your mind! Gemini North Node can be a super brain, but you need to open your mind. Listen to what others have to say and engage with them instead of ignoring them or talking over them. Engage with others, respect their opinions, and be open and honest with them and yourself. Honesty is the best policy!

You can be a super idea person, so you have to learn to be confident in the ideas you have. Your ideas can get you out of jams and open up new opportunities for you, if you let them. Take in new information, new facts and figures, and advice from others. Gather all of this together and put together plans and come up with even more ideas.

Gemini governs your immediate environment, so Gemini North Node has to learn to connect to what's around you. You don't have to always run off! What you're looking for might be right under your nose. Develop a solid connection to your community, neighborhood, and the people you're around daily.

North Node in Cancer

Cancer governs foundation, so if your internal foundation feels shaky, then work on strengthening that right away. The stronger your internal foundation is, the more you can build on it. 10th house: naturally connects to Capricorn so amplifies the energy, makes goals and ambitions and direction more important

11th house: be mature in friendships and groups, your goals get you closer to achieving your dreams

12th house: be ambitious in the background, work on your goals on your own, take a practical approach to spirituality

North Node in Aquarius

Be unique! Aquarius North Node is meant to be an individual. Embrace what's different about you, and show the world what makes you special. In turn, you can help others to embrace their differences, and bring everyone together. This makes you important to them and to the world. We all need you to remind us to be ourselves, no matter how different that is!

Aquarius is a highly objective sign, so you need to get out of being overly personal and subjective and focus on being more objective. Take a wider view of life and the world. Think about not just the big picture, but the future and where everything leads to eventually. Think outside of the box and understand how you can have a positive impact on the world.

Friendships and groups are ruled by Aquarius, so meet lots of people and make lots of friends. Keep your social circle wide and diverse, and be open to all. These connections can help you feel more stable and secure, which allows you to focus on causes to champion.

Be open to change. Change can be a good thing, and is often necessary to get what we want. In your case, change may accompany any of the big, important things that happen in your life, but it doesn't have to be out of control upheaval. It can be positive if you control it.

North Node in Pisces

Be soulful! Pisces North Node is meant to dive into the soul. Your soul is strong and powerful, though you may be scared of that at first. But it offers an opportunity for you to develop a solid intuition that can help you through any situation, and this can help to ground you and ease your stress. Focus on your spiritual self, your spiritual wants and needs, and spiritual pursuits. This can open up so much for you.

There can be a super creative or artistic side to you, and your imagination can be active if you let it. You may feel you need to be more practical and focused, but really, you need to let your imagination take over sometimes. Let it wander, let it fly. Open up to your creative or artistic energy, and see what wonders you can create.

A part of you may be kinda hard on yourself, demanding irrational perfection, so let that go and let yourself be flawed. Let yourself fail. Let yourself screw up! Being too careful can keep you from experiencing anything in life, and feeling like you have to live up to certain standards may just be holding you back. Let it go.

Accept yourself as you are. Don't see that as a bad thing, but as a beautiful thing! You can only be you, and there's nothing wrong with that.

Pisces North Node in the houses:

1st house: showcase your spirituality, embrace your flaws and imperfections, be openly imaginative

2nd house: spiritual pursuits can help you feel grounded, you can use your intuition for financial decisions, your values may be dictated by your spirituality

3rd house: imagination can be super strong and active, highly compassionate in communications, connect to your subconscious mind

4th house: as you develop your spiritual self, this can ground you emotionally, which can provide strong emotional intuition, can be extra compassionate with family

5th house: super creative, channel your imagination and spiritual energy into your creativity and allow it to be as it is and not a specific idea of perfection

6th house: is polar opposite Pisces so may volley between the two energies; may need to integrate and balance the mundane with imagination

7th house: focus on spiritual connections in relationships, extra compassionate with others, let go of perfection in your relationships

8th house: can transform spiritually and become super intuitive and mystical, spirituality can lead to finding personal power

9th house: your beliefs may be shaped by your spirituality, life experiences may be had for the spiritual fulfillment they can give you

10th house: your intuition can guide you to the goals you pursue and how to pursue them, spiritual goals may be important to you

11th house: focus on spiritual connections in friendships, your intuition can guide you with your dreams, you can be super compassionate and want to help others

12th house: naturally connects to Pisces so amplifies the energy, makes spirituality, intuition, and creativity even more important

Here are some basic interpretations for each planet on the North Node:

Sun

When your natal Sun is conjunct the North Node, this can make it much easier for you to gravitate toward your North Node because it feels more comfortable for you than for others. People usually find the North Node to be uncomfortable and so they shy away from it, but with your Sun conjunct the North Node, you usually feel much less discomfort, making it easier for you to manifest your North Node energy. I also find this position tends to be a “lucky” one, and you can make positive things happen in your life with greater ease.

Moon

When your natal Moon is conjunct the North Node, embracing your emotional side can be a big benefit for you. Using your emotions to drive you and inspire you can spurn you on to do more and be more. You can be a wonderfully nurturing and supportive person when you let go of the fear of doing so, and family can be important for you, though it may be one you create more than the one you're born into, and you need to allow yourself to have it. Women can also be important in your life, and you may find that certain women or one in particular has a strong influence in helping you become your best self.

Mercury

When your natal Mercury is conjunct the North Node, you can have a powerful mind, but it may be difficult for you to embrace at first, especially when young. You may feel like your mind is inferior in some way, but when you conquer that, you can come up with incredible ideas, be an amazing communicator, and have a way of reaching people's minds. Expressing what's on your mind is important for you, and when you feel you can do so in a clear and effective way, this helps you to fully manifest your North Node.

Venus

When your natal Venus is conjunct the North Node, your relationships can have power and you can find inspiration and strength through them, but you may feel uncomfortable with relationships or commitment at first, especially when young. It becomes important for you to learn how to have healthy relationships, and once you do, you can manifest your North Node energy more easily. It's also important for you to embrace your feminine side (even if you're a man), and to get in touch with your physical body and the physical world around you.

Mars

When your natal Mars is conjunct the North Node, you can be driven and enthusiastic about life, but being assertive and taking charge may be something that scares you at first, especially when young. Being assertive and taking charge are exactly what you need to do though, and when you can move forward in your life as your own force, you can

positively manifest your North Node energy. It's also important for you to embrace your masculine side (even if you're a woman), and to not be afraid of being a leader, because you can be a powerful one. Your life force is strong and you need to let yourself glow.

Jupiter

When your natal Jupiter is conjunct the North Node, you can create many opportunities for expansion and for new experiences, and be an explorer, but this may scare you at first, especially when young. You may avoid trying new experiences, going to new places, or going outside of your little world, but you need to push past the fences in your mind and life and get out there. The freedom that scares you may be what feeds your soul. Be bold, be brave, be fierce. When you're manifesting your North Node positively, you can have some luck on your side too.

Saturn

When your natal Saturn is conjunct the North Node, this can make it difficult for you to access your North Node energy for some time, usually until after the age of 30 or so (after your first Saturn Return, when Saturn returns to the exact placement he was at when you were born). You may have some more hurdles to jump through to manifest your Saturn on the North Node, but once you do, you can be powerfully ambitious, build a life for yourself that can't be torn down, and are seen as someone wise, responsible, and mature.

Uranus

When your natal Uranus is conjunct the North Node, there can be a super eccentric side to you that you need to embrace, but you may shy away from it, especially when young, perhaps wanting to fit in a little too much. But you're not like everyone else, and you're not supposed to be, and when you embrace the parts of yourself that are weird or strange, this is when you can feel most like yourself and happiest in your life. You're meant to be someone who goes outside of their comfort zone willingly and pushes boundaries in healthy ways.

Neptune

When your natal Neptune is conjunct the North Node, you can be a wonderfully mystical being, imaginative and intuitive, compassionate and sweet, but the other world that you can tap into may be something that scares you, especially when young, and you may insist on reality as much as possible, but that's not your destiny. You can sense what you can't see and feel what you can't touch. Connect to your soul, and let your soul connect with others.

Pluto

When your natal Pluto is conjunct the North Node, you can be so strong, so powerful, have such an incredible will, but it can be terrifying for you to embrace your power. You may feel it stirring deep inside of you, but you don't want to go there at first, especially when young. But you need

to go there, to the deepest parts of yourself, and take hold of the power within you. You also may need to undergo a big transformation in your life before you can fully manifest your North Node energy. Once you do, there can be very little that stands in your way, and you command respect and have an air of authority that no one wants to mess with.

Chiron

When your natal Chiron is conjunct the North Node, you can be a powerful healer for yourself and for others, and have innate wisdom, but this may scare you at first, especially when young. The wounds may seem like too much for you to face, but once you get over the fear and embrace the healer you are, you can be such a wonderful influence on others, and can help yourself and others move on from the wounds of the past and the hurts of the present.

So, how can you best manifest your North Node sign, house, and planets? Make a plan:

Unit 2: White Moon Selena

White Moon Selena is essentially a guardian angel in our chart. This position gives good karma, some ease, and protection. Such a nice counter to all of the challenges! White Moon Selena can give a quiet strength, and help to shine a light on our path. Some view White Moon Selena as a point that shows where we are now rewarded for what we did in past lives (as opposed to the challenges and obstacles that come from past life positions like the South Node).

It's said White Moon Selena has 3 levels, with the first being when you're unaware of the energy so it operates unconsciously; the second being when you begin to see the energy but not fully understand; and the third being when you are consciously aware and understand. As you evolve, you go through each.

I find that those who do work that helps others, whether traditionally or not (like in spiritual work), Selena tends to figure prominently in some way. Often in Libra or the 7th house (ruling others), or conjunct a personal planet. Which is funny because I think we tend to not feel very protected in our lives, which pushes us in that direction in the first place. We may inherently sense we can be guardians for others without realizing we have it for ourselves internally.

Interpretations will be given for White Moon Selena in the signs and houses and aspecting the natal planets (only major aspects will be used).

If your White Moon Selena is anaretic or critical, this may show issues associated with feeling protected and like you're on the right path. If White Moon Selena is intercepted, this can show a subconscious block that needs to be addressed so you can get on the right path.

Make note: What sign and house does your natal White Moon Selena fall in, and what major aspects does it make:

White Moon Selena in the Signs

White Moon Selena in Aries

Aries is an active sign, so you're someone who must take action in your life. Letting things go on their own isn't fitting for you! Stand up and take action. You can protect yourself and anyone around you, and other people may look to you to take charge, to show the way, and to be the guard. Aries is the sign of the warrior, so you may have some luck on your side when you're fighting, but it needs to be for the right reasons, pursuing causes and missions that are for the good of all. Where you may pursue the fight and take action may be directed at the areas of life ruled by the house your White Moon Selena falls in.

White Moon Selena in Taurus

Taurus is the grounded sign, so you're someone who benefits from being grounded. Focus on building stability and security in your life, and take action in slow and steady ways. You can commit yourself to something once you get moving, and can see things through to the end. Taurus is very in the moment, so you can find some pleasure in everyday, mundane things. You can use resources in new ways to benefit yourself and others, and you may feel a strong spiritual connection to the Earth. Where you may focus on grounding and use

resources may be directed at the areas of life ruled by the house your White Moon Selena falls in.

White Moon Selena in Gemini

Gemini is the sign of the mind, so you can benefit from your mind and communications. Finding a way of properly expressing yourself can be important for you to feel secure. Information you need is always at hand, and people you need to talk to are always available when you're manifesting this properly. Keep your mind open, and take on all of the knowledge you can so you can use that to come up with new ideas and ways of doing things. You can share the knowledge you acquire with others. Where you may focus on taking on information and expressing yourself most may be directed at the areas of life ruled by the house your White Moon Selena falls in.

White Moon Selena in Cancer

Cancer is the sign of emotion, so you can benefit from strong emotional connections, both your own connection to your emotional self and the emotional connection you have with others. You can be incredibly nurturing and supportive of those you care about, especially family (even when they don't deserve it!). Having a solid connection to your emotions can help you develop a strong intuition, and you can sense subtle energies, past experiences, and karmic baggage emotionally.

Where you may focus your emotions most may be directed at the areas of life ruled by the house your White Moon Selena falls in.

White Moon Selena in Leo

Leo rules the heart, so you can benefit from connecting to your heart and expressing love and affection. Be warm, be caring, be giving, be kind. Creative energy can be strong, and expressing yourself creatively can help you feel stable and secure. You can turn up your inner light and shine that light on others to help them with their own path. You may have to work on being more self-aware, and this can keep you on the right path. Where you may focus love and creativity most may be directed at the areas of life ruled by the house your White Moon Selena falls in.

White Moon Selena in Virgo

Virgo is an analytical sign, so you can benefit from a reasoned, practical approach to whatever you do. You can implement order and structure, and this can help you do more. You can be a good worker, and can get others to work better with or for you. Tending to health and healing can be important for you, and you can help others to heal as well with the knowledge and experience you gain. You can uncover information that others may overlook with an uncanny eye for the details. Where you may focus on being practical, ordered, work hard, and heal may be

directed at the areas of life ruled by the house your White Moon Selena falls in.

White Moon Selena in Libra

Libra is the sign of relationships, so you can benefit from connecting with others. You may feel that the people in your life offer you the greatest opportunities and rewards, and you may want to help others. You can be an excellent diplomat, keeping everyone on the same page and helping them come together in the world. You can keep the peace, maintain justice, and size people up quickly. You can understand how best to get people to take action. Where you may focus on connecting, compromising, and keeping the peace may be directed at the areas of life ruled by the house your White Moon Selena falls in.

White Moon Selena in Scorpio

Scorpio is the sign of transformation, so you may benefit from transforming and evolving. You can learn important lessons from transformations, from defeats and failures, and you can rise in more powerful ways. You can make it through many ordeals and come out stronger. using power may be directed at the areas of life ruled by the house your White Moon Selena falls in.

White Moon Selena in Sagittarius

Live in your truth, and others will look up to you. You may be a natural teacher, and the experiences you have and wisdom you gain can be passed on to others that can benefit from it. Where you may focus on living your truth and sharing your knowledge most may be directed at the areas of life ruled by the house your White Moon Selena falls in.

White Moon Selena in Capricorn

Capricorn governs goals, so you can strive to achieve the goals you set for yourself, and ultimately achieve them (though it may come after a long time of hard work and determination). This sign is also ruler of responsibility, and you may be someone who has to take on many responsibilities of others. You can do so of your own free will though, and understand that you can handle what others can't. This can lead to rewards down the road, and you can show others the right way to do things. Where you may focus on goals and responsibilities most may be

directed at the areas of life ruled by the house your White Moon Selena falls in.

White Moon Selena in Aquarius

Aquarius is the rebel, so you may benefit from pursuing the unconventional route. You can be true to yourself, and encourage others to do the same. You can embrace your independence, and may operate best when you're free to be independent and innovative. You can pursue changes that benefit you, and you can show others how to push outside of tradition to something new and different. You can care a lot for the world and everything in it, and can be a champion. Where you may focus on being unconventional, independent, and a champion most may be directed at the areas of life ruled by the house your White Moon Selena falls in.

White Moon Selena in Pisces

Pisces is a highly intuitive sign, so you may benefit most when you forge a strong connection to your intuition. You may unconsciously tap into the subtle energies all around you, and can be guided without conscious awareness. Your compassion can run high, and you can help others who truly need your need, even when others won't. You can also be very artistic and creative with an active imagination, and can use this as an outlet, a profession, or a way of helping others. Where you may

focus on using intuition, being compassionate, and being creative most may be directed at the areas of life ruled by the house your White Moon Selena falls in.

White Moon Selena in the Houses

1st House: You can come across as White Moon Selena in some way - highly intuitive, spiritual, evolving, healing, responsible. You can be your own guardian. This is a great healer position, and you can show others how to help themselves, acting as a guide simply in your way of living your life and being. The more you evolve, the more you can use this ability to help the world.

2nd House: As this is the house of values, you may be someone who always has what you need if you have faith and live a moral life, but perhaps not much more than that, at least until you focus on values beyond money and possessions. The more you evolve, the more you may come to have.

3rd House: As this is a communication house, you may be someone who benefits from open communication and expression. Your words may seem more powerful to others, and you can share what you think, but may need to focus more on your own opinions instead of being guided by others. The more you evolve, the more powerful your words may become.

4th House: As this is the house of home and family, you may be someone who benefits from creating a solid and supportive home and family life, as well as a strong internal self and foundation. There may be

lessons to learn emotionally before you can achieve this though. The more you evolve, the more support you may have.

5th House: As this is the house of love, you may be someone who benefits from sharing the love you feel openly with others. Your heart can be big and warm and caring, so you just have to keep ego from getting in the way, or a desperate need for approval. The more you evolve, the more love you may have in your life.

6th House: As this is the house of work, you may be someone who benefits from work. This may be professional work or the work of daily life or taking care of others. Being of service is something that can be fulfilling for you, but you do have to curb perfectionism and being self-judging. The more you evolve, the more work you can do.

7th House: As this is the house of relationships, you may be someone who benefits from relationships and helping others. Your path is likely not one meant to be walked alone or solely for your own benefit. Find the knowledge available to you within your relationships, and use that to find yourself. The more you evolve, the more you can be interconnected.

8th House: As this is the house of shared resources, you may be someone who benefits from the shared resources you have with others. You may be skillful in your ability to use the resources you have, and

can use them to find more power, take control, and transform. The more you evolve, the more you may have to use.

9th House: As this is the house of higher learning and travel, you may be someone who benefits from both. You can be an eternal student of the world, and share your wisdom with others. You may travel the world, and learn from your experiences, sharing that with others as well. The more you evolve, the more you can experience and learn.

10th House: As this is the house of goals, you may be someone who benefits from focusing on your goals. You can merge both logic and reason with intuition and heart to make decisions and determine your path, and you can have a big impact in doing so. The more you evolve, the more you can achieve and more respect you can attain.

11th House: As this is the house of friends and groups, you may be someone who benefits from working with friends or groups. Your vision of the future can be clear, and this can help you focus on what needs to be done now to help the world in the future. Your dreams may connect with your causes. The more you evolve, the more you can have a positive impact.

12th House: As this is the house of the hidden, you may be someone who benefits from time alone, away from others, reflecting and understanding the past and connecting to the subconscious mind. You

may subconsciously use your White Moon Selena energy, especially in situations where you're protective. The more you evolve, the more you can understand.

Natal Planets to White Moon Selena

Note that aspects are kept to tighter orbs with a point like White Moon Selena (since it's not a physical object but an imaginary, invisible force). The closer to aspect, the stronger it may be.

When the natal Sun is conjunct White Moon Selena, you may feel your inner protector strong, and this can help you follow your path and help others as well. You may be a healer, and as you evolve, you heal and grow in big ways. Sextiles and trines between these two can make healing, growth, and protecting easier for you, while squares and oppositions may show you don't feel as connected and have to work on it. There may be a block internally with the square, or challenges from others with the opposition.

When the natal Moon is conjunct White Moon Selena, you may be deeply nurturing and supportive, and need that in return to feel safe. Your home/family life can be very important to helping you, and you may be very protective of them. Emotional instincts may be strong. Sextiles and trines between these two can make it easier for you to nurture yourself emotionally so you grow and help others, while squares and oppositions might create challenges that need to be overcome. There may be internally emotional issues with the square, or emotional challenges externally with the opposition.

When natal Mercury is conjunct White Moon Selena, your communication skills can be strong. You may be someone that others listen to, though you may have to evolve and grow first. Having a healthy connection to your mind can do you a lot of good. Sextiles and trines between these two can make it easier for you to connect to your mind and express yourself openly, while squares and oppositions might bring difficulties with communication until you work through them. This may involve focusing internally with the square, primarily on insecurity or perfectionism, or through working on external challenges with the opposition.

When natal Venus is conjunct White Moon Selena, you can be incredibly protective of the people in your life, and want to help them heal and grow, or may be attracted to people who are healers and evolved. You may heal and grow yourself through others and the relationships you have, as well as by being grounded and in tune with your body. Sextiles and trines between these two can make it easier for you to help others and find balance, while squares and oppositions can present difficulties with having healthy boundaries.

When natal Mars is conjunct White Moon Selena, you can take the initiative with your healing and growth, and the more you enthusiastically pursue what you want, the more you can evolve. Your instincts can be strong, and you can feel guided. Sextiles and trines between these two can make it easier for you to take action and feel

confident in your choices, while squares and oppositions may bring challenges with impulse and impatience that needs to be addressed.

When natal Jupiter is conjunct White Moon Selena, once you start on the right path, you can heal and grow, evolve and find your light

easily. You can unlock opportunities when you embrace growing and learning about yourself, and you may feel better about life. Sextiles and trines between these two can make it easier for you to know what your path is and how to stay true to your light, while squares and oppositions may bring difficulties with laziness getting in the way.

When natal Saturn is conjunct White Moon Selena, you may feel

restricted in your ability to grow and find your path. There may be lessons that have to be learned first, and they may be hard, but ultimately must be learned so you're free to get on your path. Once you do, you can commit to it and reach incredible heights. Sextiles and trines between these two can make it easier for you to be disciplined and focused on your path, while squares and oppositions may bring challenges with major blocks and issues that have to be worked on. You may feel you'll never find your path, but you have to stick with doing things the right way and for the right reasons, and it can become clear eventually.

When natal Uranus is conjunct White Moon Selena, you can embrace your individuality and focus on causes to help others, and this helps

you evolve. You may find that your path is an unusual one, highly unconventional, and the way to get on it may be different, so embracing that may be something to work on. Sextiles and trines between these two can make it easier for you to embrace the unconventional and champion causes, while squares and oppositions may be more difficult. There may be erratic energy that has to be dealt with.

When natal Neptune is conjunct White Moon Selena, you can be super compassionate, super intuitive, and super imaginative. Your healing abilities can be superb, and you can be extremely caring of others. You may need to focus on consciously connecting to your intuition and soul so you can use this energy productively. Sextiles and trines between these two can make it easier for you to connect, while squares and oppositions can bring challenges, especially with lack of focus or boundaries. Get clear and have healthy boundaries.

When natal Pluto is conjunct White Moon Selena, you may feel your inner power is strong. There is a passionate force inside of you, and this can be a part of your path in life. There may be a transformation necessary before that can happen though. Sextiles and trines between these two can make it easier for you to transform and wield your power, while squares and oppositions can highlight issues with power and control that need to be worked on.

When natal Chiron is conjunct White Moon Selena, you can be an incredibly healer, of both yourself and of others. This may be a part of your path in life, but there are likely wounds that need to be healed first before you can find your path. Sextiles and trines between these two can make it easier for you to heal those wounds, while squares and oppositions can make it difficult, causing re-openings or self-sabotage that has to be addressed.

When natal Black Moon Lilith is conjunct White Moon Selena, the dark meets the light! Your light and dark sides may be one, different sides of the same coin. Standing up and speaking out may be a part of your path, and evolving can help you with embracing your hidden inner power. Sextiles and trines between these two can make it easier for you to feel powerful and balance the light and dark, while squares and oppositions might bring out challenges to doing so. Remove blocks and focus on balance.

When your natal North Node is conjunct White Moon Selena, this can show that you may shy away from evolving and finding your path, feeling uncomfortable and uncertain. You may have to trust in the Universe - and in yourself! - and go for it anyway. The more you evolve, the further you can get, and the closer you can get to realizing your full potential. Sextiles and trines between these two can make it easier for you to push forward. **When opposite, White Moon Selena is conjunct the South Node, and you may have an innate sense of your path, but**

may fall back to self-righteousness or becoming a little too focused on evolving (to the point of erratic energy). When square, White Moon Selena is square both the North and South Node, and you may have to work on blocks that are keeping you from evolving. This can also act as a block to fully integrating the past and future, what's been and what will be, and resolve spiritual, karmic issues so you can let go of some baggage.

So, how can you best use your White Moon Selena sign, house, and aspects?

Unit 3: Jupiter

The energy of Jupiter is expansion, at its core. This applies both in transit as well as in the natal chart. This means Jupiter expands on the good, making it even better, but can also expand on the bad, making it even worse! The difference with Jupiter compared to say, Saturn, is that you can turn things around more easily by doing things the right way. Jupiter is the happy planet, and wants everything to go well so you can expand more, and doesn't want to hold you down for long.

In your natal chart, the sign and house position of your natal Jupiter can show where you'll have the most opportunities for expansion in life, and where it can be easiest for you to expand, explore, and experience. So much is possible via Jupiter!

When you want to turn life around, Jupiter is one of the planets you can look to for assistance. This can be an area where you can have an easier time, and the energy can benefit you. You don't have to push against Jupiter too hard.

Since Jupiter spends about a year in each sign, the house location tends to be primary for interpretation, so interpretations will be given for Jupiter by house. Planets conjuncts your natal Jupiter get expanded in your chart, and this can be an additional area where you have more opportunities and possibilities.

Jupiter in the signs can alter the way your Jupiter operates in the house it's located. Jupiter in the signs:

Aries: This will give more energy and drive to expand, explore, and have experiences with whatever areas of life the house rules.

Taurus: This will provide a more stable, steady focus on expanding, exploring, and new experiences with whatever areas of life the house rules.

Gemini: This will give ideas and a mental focus on expansion, exploring, and experiencing with whatever areas of life the house rules.

Cancer: This will give an emotional focus and drive for expansion, exploration, and new experiences with whatever areas of life the house rules.

Leo: This will stimulate creativity in expanding, exploring, and experiencing with whatever areas of life the house rules.

Virgo: This will make focus practical, detailed, and work-oriented with expanding, exploring, and experiencing with whatever areas of life the house rules.

Libra: This will make balance and working with others to expand, explore, and have new experiences with whatever areas of life the house rules.

Scorpio: This will bring passion and intensity for expanding, exploring, and experiencing with whatever areas of life the house rules.

Sagittarius: This is the sign Jupiter naturally rules, so expansion, exploration, and experiences can be pursued with optimism and openness with the areas of life ruled by the house.

Capricorn: This will bring a disciplined approach and focus on goals with expansion, exploration, and new experiences with whatever areas of life the house rules.

Aquarius: This will bring an unconventional approach and independence with expansion, exploration, and new experiences with whatever areas of life the house rules.

Pisces: This will bring a spiritual approach and intuitive guidance with expansion, exploration, and new experiences with whatever areas of life the house rules.

Make note: What sign and house does your natal Jupiter fall in? Are any planets conjunct?

Natal Jupiter in the Houses

Natal Jupiter in 1st house House

This can be a pretty lucky position, when you're not foolhardy anyway! This is a position where you have some positive energy on your side at almost all times. You can be more open with what you want and pursue opportunities more easily, though you may struggle with laziness sometimes and have to work to find motivation (check your Mars).

Confidence can be an asset for you, and you can see the world in a positive light, though not necessarily unrealistically (that's Neptune's job). You're just more of a silver lining kind of person. Though if you do get down and sour, you can get worse quickly, so you do have to snap yourself out of it fast.

The 1st house is the start of the houses, so you may be someone who can take initiative and start lots of new things all of the time. A new journey, new venture, new path likely excites you, and you can throw yourself into the new. The trick is just sticking with it long enough to make some progress!

HOW TO FIND OPPORTUNITY:

- Take initiative
- Focus on new ventures, projects, paths

- Be confident

Natal Jupiter in the 2nd House

This is a great position because the 2nd house rules money! So you're someone who likely always seems to have as much as you need (maybe not as much as you want though - yet!). Jupiter in the 2nd house often shows a great ability to make a *lot* of money in your life. Just gotta get up and get moving!

The 2nd house also a kick back house, so relaxing and indulging is probably something you like a lot. You can benefit when you're in the moment and not stressing so much about the past or future. Stick to right now, and take things slow and steady as you move forward. Stability and security can do you a lot of good and help open up opportunities for you.

This house also governs your values, so you may want to focus on making sure you have a solid value system that you feel connected to, and that you live by, whatever it may be. Your values should be true to you and support your life.

HOW TO FIND OPPORTUNITY:

- Get moving
- But not too fast! Slow and steady wins the race
- Have solid values to ground you

Natal Jupiter in the 3rd House

This is the house of the mind, so you can have a super brain! You may find lots of different subjects interesting, and take in lots of information. You may love to learn, and your brain can be an asset. You may need to work on focusing your brain on what you should rather than on random stuff. Easy to be sidetracked! If you stay focused, your ideas can be put to good use, and you can be quite the idea generator.

Communication can be an asset for you as well, and you can be more open in your communications, and can find others to be more open with you. You can freely share what's on your mind, and engage with others. Your communication skills may be seen as one of your strengths.

You likely need to be kept busy at all times since this is an active house. Keep your schedule full, and stay on the move.

HOW TO FIND OPPORTUNITY:

- Focus your mind
- Put ideas to good use
- Communicate!

Natal Jupiter in the 4th House

This is the house of home and family, so having a happy home and family life is very important for you. You can create the kind of home and family life you want, and this can be something that supports you in whatever you do. Support is something you need in order to pursue opportunities, and you can start looking for it at home. If your home base is wonky, then it can become more difficult for you.

You can help take care of others, and want the same in return. The 4th house is very nurturing, so you want to be nurtured and nurture others. Make sure the flow is going both ways to keep it constant and steady.

The 4th house is the bottom of the chart, governing your core and internal foundation, so at your core, you're likely a positive person who instinctively feels you know what to do at all times. Your instincts can help guide you, and can be a quiet asset that helps you find opportunities and expand.

HOW TO FIND OPPORTUNITY:

- Create a happy home/family life
- Nurture and be nurtured
- Trust your instincts

Natal Jupiter in the 5th House

This is one of the most creative positions. So make use of that creative energy inside of you! You'll want to pursue creative projects and ventures so you can channel that creative energy into something productive and tangible. This position can also lead to some laziness, so don't let that take over!

Your hobbies can be something that you don't just enjoy, you really really really love; while work may be something you struggle with. So try to make work something that is fun, and uses your creativity or is one of your hobbies. Making a hobby profitable is absolutely something you're capable of!

Love is important for you, and you can have a big heart. This can play out in your personal relationships, but it can reach out into every area of life. Let love and your heart lead you.

HOW TO FIND OPPORTUNITY:

- Use creative energy productively
- Make hobbies profitable
- Let your heart lead you

Natal Jupiter in the 6th House

This position can bring a little luck to your work life, and you may fall into the right jobs at the right times with the right people. But, you can also be lazy with work, which can get you in trouble, and when you're in a job you hate, you really really hate it. So the most important consideration with this position is to be doing work (or whatever your daily life focus is) that you enjoy. If you don't, you may not last in anything for very long. If you do, you can make big progress!

You can find more opportunities through organization, paying attention to the details, and having some structure, order, and routine. Haphazard isn't really going to cut it. At the same time, you need some degree of space in your daily life. Anyone suffocating you needs to go!

The 6th house rules health, so you're likely a fairly healthy person, but taking care of your physical needs can help open up more opportunities for you in life. So listen to your body, treat it like a temple, and try not to overindulge too much.

HOW TO FIND OPPORTUNITY:

- Focus on work you love
- Get organized and have some space
- Take care of you health

Natal Jupiter in the 7th House

This is the house of relationships, so you're someone who can find lots of opportunities through other people, or working with other people. A partner can help keep you on track and focused on what needs to be done, and make you feel supported enough to take a chance on yourself. And you can be supportive in return!

You're someone who likely wants to keep the peace and not get dragged into crazy drama, and your compromising, mediating, and negotiating skills can be impressive. Middle ground can be where you're at home, and you can turn up the charm and know how to be diplomatic, while also considering what everyone needs.

You may benefit from balance, and striking a balance in your life may open up more for you. The more out of balance you feel you are, the harder it can be for you to expand and explore. So try not to let things get out of whack.

HOW TO FIND OPPORTUNITY:

- Work with others
- Compromise
- Maintain balance

Natal Jupiter in the 8th House

You're someone who is likely not missing any passion in life! Whatever you pursue, you can do so with great passion and a sense of purpose. You can dedicate yourself to whatever you're focused on, and can become incredibly invested. This can help you to push through any difficulties and make progress where everyone else would give up. This can help make you researching, and you can get to the core of any situation or person.

This house rules shared resources, so you may benefit from having a business or financial partner. You can also benefit from sharing what you have openly with others, especially those you're closest to.

The 8th house is ruled by Pluto the transformer, so you may also benefit from making transformations in your life or of yourself. Make something old new again, restore the shine, breathe new life into what was lifeless. This can be a great asset and skill throughout your life.

HOW TO FIND OPPORTUNITY:

- Use passion productively
- Share what you have
- Transform

Natal Jupiter in the 9th House

This is the house that Jupiter naturally rules, so this makes your Jupiter extra strong! And it means you're more comfortable with expansion, exploration, and new experiences. You can focus on opportunities to expand, always wanting to make life as big and bold as possible. Your optimism can be high and helpful.

This position usually loves to communicate in some way, often through writing or speaking, and you can share what you've learned about life and the world with others. You can enjoy learning and teaching, though perhaps not traditionally (depending on sign).

You can be open to the world and everyone in it, wanting to gain as much understanding of other ways of living as possible. You can approach life with enthusiasm, and this helps open up more opportunities for you.

HOW TO FIND OPPORTUNITY:

- Make life big and bold
- Find your way of communicating
- Approach life enthusiastically

Natal Jupiter in the 10th House

The 10th house governs your goals and ambitions, so you can be someone who is incredibly ambitious and focused on what you want to achieve and succeed. You can achieve and succeed in big ways when you put your mind to it, and you can be presented with opportunities to be in the spotlight in some way. This position can make it easier for you to succeed in a career once you find what you want to do.

You can connect with the right people in the right places who can help you to have success. You can attract the attention of people you respect, and you can get respect from others. Once you start experiencing success, you can be seen as someone to look up to by others.

Having a plan and sticking to it can help you. You can think about your direction in life and what you want to achieve, and work on plans for them. You just have to make sure you don't give in to laziness with pursuing them.

HOW TO FIND OPPORTUNITY:

- Focus on goals and ambitions
- Connect with the right people
- Stick to your plans

Natal Jupiter in the 11th House

The 11th house rules your friends and groups, so you can benefit from working with friends or in groups for whatever you want to be doing. You may be more comfortable in front of a group or crowd, and this can be helpful for attracting attention in big ways. You can be open to new people, and making many connections with others can be helpful.

This house also rules your dreams for the future, so you're someone who may dream big and bright, and feel like it's not unrealistic. You can believe in your dreams, and in your ability to achieve them. You usually just have to watch for laziness and talking the talk but not walking the walk.

You may also benefit from being independent, innovative, and unconventional. You're likely not someone meant to do things the traditional way. You're meant to do them in your own way, and step outside of your comfort zone.

HOW TO FIND OPPORTUNITY:

- Work with friends or groups and make lots of connections
- Work on your dreams
- Be independent, innovative, and unconventional

Natal Jupiter in the 12th House

You can have a little guardian angel with you at all times, and this can help make you feel more secure. It can seem like everything will work out in the end, so you don't need to worry and fret over too much. Stay calm, stay quiet, and believe that everything will be okay, and you don't need to stress.

Your spirituality can be very important to you, and having a strong connection to your spiritual self can be beneficial. You may also benefit from having a good connection to your subconscious mind, and to your intuition. That can guide you through anything you go through.

You may benefit most from doing things along though. You may find other people tend to drain your opportunities in some way, so it can be better for you to pursue them on your own. Once you achieve what you set out to do, you can share the rewards with others openly, and want to help other people as much as you can.

HOW TO FIND OPPORTUNITY:

- Believe everything will be okay
- Connect to your spiritual self, subconscious mind, and intuition
- Work on your own

Natal Planets Conjunct Natal Jupiter

Note that the conjunction is what'll be covered, but you can adjust for sextiles/trines and squares/oppositions. Sextiles/trines will focus on the positives but with less intensity, while squares/oppositions have extra laziness to manage (but can still be fairly positive with Jupiter):

The **Sun or Moon** conjunct your natal Jupiter is one of the best positions to have! It gives great opportunity in life and usually shows you'll be provided for no matter what. Luck can be on your side, and you can create your own (especially with the Sun). With the Moon, there can be helpful connections with your family. Your optimism can be a great asset, and you can believe that things will work out (and then make it work!). There can be a tendency toward laziness or not following through, so just make sure you don't slide into that.

Mercury conjunct your natal Jupiter expands your mind and gives you great ideas and plans. You can get excited by your ideas, and can get opportunities to make them happen. Pushing yourself to take action with them may be needed, but once you get going, you can unlock even more opportunities. You may be an idea person, and you may seem to never have a shortage of them. Your outlook can also be very optimistic, which can help with challenges.

Venus conjunct your natal Jupiter can bring important connections into your life that help you to expand and explore. Opportunities may come through other people, and you can benefit from your relationships and partnerships. You may be very committed yet also require a certain amount of space in your relationships (clingy is probably not for you!). There can be an ease to the way you approach situations and people in your life, and when you're not pushing too hard, you may find that things fall into place.

Mars conjunct your natal Jupiter makes you someone who can act on what you want, taking initiative and creating opportunities for yourself. Jupiter tends to be on the lazy side but Mars is all action, so Mars-Jupiter can squash the laziness. You can create what you want for yourself and don't have to wait for anyone to do it for you. You create your own luck! The more focused you can be with this energy, the more you can accomplish.

Saturn conjunct your natal Jupiter can be a challenge at times since Saturn is restrictive and Jupiter is expansive, so when they're together you have to find some balance between the two and integrate their energy positively. Take a disciplined approach (Saturn) to expansion and opportunity (Jupiter). Maintain openness (Jupiter) as you pursue your goals (Saturn). Saturn tends to try to overtake Jupiter when they're conjunct, so try not to let that happen.

Uranus conjunct your natal Jupiter can make you a super independent person. You can do things your own way, push outside of your comfort zone, and enjoy the unconventional. You may feel some connection to the changing times, and can adjust as that change happens. Change in general may be something that opens up more opportunities to you and can be used to explore and have new experiences.

Neptune conjunct your natal Jupiter can make you a super spiritual person. Your intuition can be strong, and you can feel guided by the subtle energies all around you. This might make you a wanderer who has a hard time setting roots or being grounded, so that is something that has to be worked on. When you can control the energy, you can use it to your advantage to give you a leg up.

Pluto conjunct your natal Jupiter gives you a very strong will, and you can be a passionate person. You may not take too much lightly, though you can also not take anything too seriously. Jupiter likes to be light while Pluto likes to be dark so you may want to strive for the middle. When you learn to control your passionate energy, you can use that to your advantage to will things to happen. You may also benefit from transforming at various points in your life.

Chiron conjunct your natal Jupiter can expand on your healing abilities, but this may not be felt right away as Jupiter expands on your wounds. You may feel them more deeply and can be extra sensitive until you

heal some of the wounds and develop better boundaries. Once you do, you can summon your healing abilities to help yourself whenever you need, and to help and understand others.

Black Moon Lilith conjunct your natal Jupiter can expand on your inner Lilith, and you may be someone who has to speak out and stand up. When others oppose you, it may seem like it's in a bigger way than for others; but you may also find that happens less often for you than for others, and you can convince others of your positions and make them understand what it is you're fighting for.

Unit 4: Asteroid Abundantia

There are a few asteroids that will be covered in this class, and one is asteroid Abundantia! Asteroid Abundantia (number 151) is literally the asteroid of abundance. In your natal chart, asteroid Abundantia can show where you can experience abundance in your life, and what your relationship with abundance is. Some of us feel more abundant than others, and some areas of life feel more abundant than others. Enter Abundantia!

Now, sometimes this can be an abundance of bad things - it's just abundance, this asteroid, and doesn't differentiate too much (similar to Jupiter in this respect). But it's an area where you can focus to try and create positive abundance consciously.

We'll focus on asteroid Abundantia in the signs/houses (which can show where you experience abundance), and major aspects to your natal planets (which can show your relationship to abundance).

P.S. There's another asteroid that is interpreted similarly to Abundantia, asteroid Fortuna (number 19), so if you want to look that one up too, go ahead!

Make note: What sign and house is your natal asteroid Abundantia located, and what major aspects does it make?

Asteroid Abundantia in the Houses/Signs

With Abundantia in your **1st house or Aries**, you may be someone who feels abundant quite a bit! You can create lots of abundance in your life, and can do it yourself without looking to others. You can take the initiative when you want to create abundance, and assert yourself. When things get really bad, sometimes they can get on a roll down; but when things get really good, sometimes they can get a roll to greatness! You may benefit from manifesting in any area of your life, with anything you want.

With Abundantia in your **2nd house or Taurus**, you may experience an abundance with money or physical objects. There may be important family heirlooms passed down to you, or you may be entrusted with things that others view as valuable. When you feel confident, you may be *really* confident; and when you're insecure, you may be *really* insecure. When it comes to money, you may find you have a lot of it sometimes, but then when it's gone, you can feel it strong. Generally speaking though, you're someone capable of having a lot of money at some point in your life.

With Abundantia in your **3rd house or Gemini**, you may have an abundance of ideas and plans. Your mind can go-go-go, always swirling, always something new. You can absorb lots of new information and facts, and it may seem like you're never short on ideas or

information or words to say. But you can get stuck in your head sometimes, and can get lost on a tangent pretty easily, so focus is something you have to work on so you can use the mental energy to your advantage.

With Abundantia in your **4th house or Cancer** you may have an abundance of emotional energy, and this can be used to inspire you and motivate you to take action, when directed properly and productively. You may want an abundant home, perhaps literally a large space; or an abundant family, perhaps literally a huge one (try not to have 20 kids!). Your family may have a big influence on you, for better or worse; and you may inherit a lot from your family (not just physical items or money, but things like personality traits and obsessions).

With Abundantia in your **5th house or Leo**, you may have an abundance of love energy. Be a lover, not a fighter! You can have a lot of creative energy as well, and you may be someone with lots of hobbies, lots of creative projects to work on, and lots of time spent doing what you love. You may get a little grumpy sometimes without it! When you're affectionate or romantic, you can really go overboard sometimes. But you have a really big heart, and can be very generous (sometimes too much!).

With Abundantia in your **6th house or Virgo**, you may have an abundance of productive energy. When you get working on something,

you can get a lot done as quickly and efficiently as possible. You may be presented with many work opportunities in your life, or try out lots of different jobs. When you don't like what you're doing, you can loathe it with a passion. When you do like it, you can love it with a passion. Since these points rule health, you can fully invest in your health, but you can also be fully lazy about it for a while!

With Abundantia in your **7th house or Libra**, you may have an abundance of people and partnerships in your life. You may be surrounded by others, and attract many new people to you. You may find more opportunities for abundance with a partner than alone. You may feel like the other people in your life are living more abundantly than you are sometimes, and may be around a lot of successful people. You may feel more abundant when you're balanced and feel you have some peace.

With Abundantia in your **8th house or Scorpio**, you may find abundance through transforming, and may transform many times in your life. There may be an abundance of shared resources as well, and you can find more abundance through sharing. You can have plenty of passionate energy, and this can be helpful when you learn to use it properly, otherwise it may just get you in trouble sometimes.

With Abundantia in your **9th house or Sagittarius**, you may find abundance through expanding your life in new ways. Expansion leads to

new experiences, and optimism helps open up to new ideas. You can think bigger and brighter, and may have an abundance of big ideas, but do need to back them up with action. You may feel abundant when you have lots of space and are free of responsibility.

With Abundantia in your **10th house or Capricorn**, you may have an abundance of professional opportunities or professional ideas you'd like to pursue. Once you have chosen a career, you can invest yourself in it. You may also take on lots of responsibilities in your life, and at times it may seem like too much, so you do need to have some space. You may feel abundant when you're making progress on your path.

With Abundantia in your **11th house or Aquarius**, you may have an abundance of friends, and are always open to meeting new people. You may have a big social circle, and can belong to many groups or take up lots of causes. You may have an abundance of dreams as well, and think a lot about the future and have a hopeful heart. You may feel abundant when you're free to be yourself.

With Abundantia in your **12th house of Pisces**, you may keep your abundance to yourself, and can feel that you're only abundant on your own or in the background. You may have plenty of spiritual interests and strong spiritual energy, but you may keep this to yourself for a while. You can be very compassionate and understanding with others, and have an active imagination that can give you an appreciation for the arts.

Asteroid Abundantia Aspects

When asteroid Abundantia is conjunct one of your natal planets, that can be a source of major abundance in your life! Conjunct the **Sun**, this can bring out an abundant approach to everything you do, and you can create abundance easily once you learn to master it. With the **Moon**, you can have an abundance of emotions, for better or worse, but can also be super supportive, nurturing, and understanding. With **Mercury**, you can have an abundance of ideas and an active mind, and you may have lots of communications and share what's on your mind. You can take a mental approach to abundance and come up with ideas to create it. With **Venus**, you may experience abundance in relationships or financially, and can take a balanced approach to abundance. With **Mars**, you may always have an abundance of energy, and you can use that energy to create abundance in your life. With **Jupiter**, you may always have an abundance of opportunities, though you may also have an abundance of laziness pretty often too! With **Saturn**, you may have an abundance of goals and ambitions, and you can succeed with hard work and determination. But you can also have an abundance of responsibilities that can weigh you down and need to be worked on. With **Uranus**, you may always have an abundance of changes going on, and you can fully embrace the unconventional. But there can also be an abundance of erratic energy to be managed. With **Neptune**, you may have an abundance of spiritual energy, and can be highly intuitive and

mystical. But you may also get stuck in the fog sometimes and have trouble with concentration. With **Pluto**, you may have an abundance of power and control at times, but you may also be controlling and need to stop that. With **Chiron**, you may have an abundance of healing energy, but also an abundance of wounds. With **Black Moon Lilith**, you may have an abundance of empowerment and speak up a lot, but you may also encounter a lot of opposition. With **White Moon Selena**, you may have an abundance of faith in your path and feel guided. With the **North Node**, you may have potential for great abundance in your life if you work through the discomfort. With the **South Node**, you may be incredibly comfortable with abundance, but sometimes lazy about it too.

When asteroid Abundantia is sextile or trine one of your natal planets, you can handle the abundance associated with it more easily and create abundance for yourself; and when it's square or opposite one of your natal planets, this may show some challenges with abundance in your life that you have to work through. This can be easier with the Sun and Moon with the sextile/trine, and more difficult with the square/opposition as it's something very person in the way; with Mercury, it can be associated with your mind and ideas; with Venus, your relationships; with Mars, your energy and drive; with Jupiter, your opportunities; with Saturn, your goals; with Uranus, your dreams; with Neptune, your spirituality; with Pluto, your passion; with Chiron, your healing; with Black Moon Lilith, your inner power; and with White Moon Selena, your path.

So, how can you make use of your asteroid Abundantia to bring abundance into your life?

Unit 5: Asteroid Talent

Our next asteroid is an asteroid named Talent (number 33154), and this asteroid literally shows where your talents are! This can be shown through the sign and house position, and your relationship with your talents can be shown through aspects to your planets.

Make note: What sign and house does your natal asteroid Talent fall in, and what major aspects does it make?

Asteroid Talent in the Signs/Houses

With asteroid Talent in your **1st house or Aries**, your talents may lie in your ability to take action, take initiative, and go for what you want. You may be talented with your energy, or have physical talents with sports or fitness. You may be talented in the way you know how to choose new projects and start new journeys, and you can have strong gut instincts that can help you along the way.

With asteroid Talent in your **2nd house or Taurus**, your talents may lie in your abilities to handle, manage, or make money. You may have an eye for things that can pay off financially, and you can make smart financial choices. Your talents can also be shown when you're feeling confident, and you may have the ability to make yourself feel more secure no matter what. One of your senses may also be extra sharp, and you can have an eye for beauty.

With asteroid Talent in your **3rd house or Gemini**, your talents may lie in your mental abilities. You can be a great communicator, speaker, writer, teacher, or student, and can be very engaging with others. You may seem to be able to multitask pretty well, juggling lots of projects all of the time with a packed schedule. You may have a talent for handling young people, which could make you a good teacher or mentor.

With asteroid Talent in your **4th house or Cancer**, your talents may lie in your emotions. You may be able to understand what others are feeling quite easily, and can use your own emotions to your advantage. You can use your emotions to inspire you, and your emotional instincts can be strong. You may feel comfortable exposing your talents when you're emotionally stable and secure, and your internal foundation is strong.

With asteroid Talent in your **5th house or Leo**, your talents may be creative ones. You can be extremely talented with your hobbies, and you may feel comfortable in the spotlight for your hobbies or creative projects. These positions can also show physical talents. You can feel comfortable exposing your talents when you're enjoying yourself and not taking things too seriously.

With asteroid Talent in your **6th house or Virgo**, your talents may focus on your ability to work. You're someone who can get a lot done in a short amount of time, working efficiently and productively, and keeping order, structure, and routine. The work that you do may need to be work that allows you to share your talents openly. You may have an eye for details that is unparalleled.

With asteroid Talent in your **7th house or Libra**, your talents may focus on your ability to deal with others. You may be a skillful negotiator and mediator, and know how to get everyone on the same page. You can handle difficult people, and may be a people person. You may attract

very talented people into your life. You can feel comfortable exposing your talents when you're balanced and peaceful.

With asteroid Talent in your **8th house or Scorpio**, your talents may lie in your ability to breathe new life into what was lifeless. You can take something old and make it new again, and you can regenerate yourself as well. Your will can be strong, and keep you going through anything. You can be skillful at research and investigation, and at finding solutions to complicated, vexing problems. You may not fully share your talents until you undergo a major transformation.

With asteroid Talent in your **9th house or Sagittarius**, your talents may focus on your ability to be open and expand. You can work on big ideas, and your optimism can be an advantage. You may be a great storyteller, marketer, or at publicity. You can be a great student as well, and can learn through life experiences. You can feel comfortable exposing your talents when you feel you have the space and freedom to do so.

With asteroid Talent in your **10th house or Capricorn**, your talents can be shown through your goals. If you're not using your talents with your goals, they're wasting away! If you have a career, it's likely one focused solely on using your talents and sharing them with the world. You can get attention for your talents, and at some point, can be looked up to for the talents you have and the way you've used them.

With asteroid Talent in your **11th house or Aquarius**, your talents may be unconventional! A little unusual perhaps, and stands out in some way. You may have a talent for doing things differently and thinking outside of the box. You can also manage groups, and may have a talent for handling lots of different people. Your dreams may focus on bigger ways to use your talents, perhaps not only for you but for everyone.

With asteroid Talent in your **12th house or Pisces**, you may not be comfortable sharing your talents openly with others. Your talents likely come out when you're alone, or with people you know very well and trust. You can be talented at managing things behind the scenes, and can be the engine that keeps everything running. You may have spiritual, metaphysical talents, a strong intuition, and can be artistically inclined.

Asteroid Talent Aspects

When you have natal planets conjunct asteroid Talent, this can be a source of great talent for you! When it's conjunct the **Sun**, you may be seen as a talented person in general, and can be incredibly creative; to the **Moon**, you can express your talents emotionally, your emotions can inspire you to express them, and you can have a talent for nurturing and encouraging people; to **Mercury**, you can have a talent with words, communicating, and expressing yourself; to **Venus**, you can have a talent for dealing with others, keeping the peace, with money, or with beauty; to **Mars**, you can have a talent for pursuing the right things at the right times, and using your energy well; to **Jupiter**, you can have a talent for finding opportunities, and may seem kinda lucky; to **Saturn**, you can have a talent for your goals, and you can achieve big success in your life; to **Uranus**, you can have a talent for what's different, innovation, and the unconventional; to **Neptune**, you can have a talent for spiritual pursuits, and can be highly intuitive; to **Pluto**, you can have a talent for taking control, transforming, and finding solutions; to **Chiron**, you can have a talent for healing and growth; to **Black Moon Lilith**, you can have a talent for empowering yourself, standing up and speaking out; to **White Moon Selena**, you can have a talent for finding your path and growing as a person through whatever you go through; to **North Node**, you're meant to find your talents in your life and showcase that to the world, and can have a knack for timing; and to **South Node**, you can

have a talent for using the past and baggage to your advantage, and you may carry over talents from past lives.

When asteroid Talent is sextile or trine one of your natal planets, you can have an easier time expressing some talents with that planet (but not strong like with the conjunction), and can use the energy of the planet to support your talents. When Talent is square or opposite one of your natal planets, the planet may block you in some way from expressing your talents and need to be worked on. With the Sun and Moon, they can be extremely supportive of your talents with the sextile/trine, and you can feel more at ease with your talents, but with the square/opposition, you can get in your own way sometimes and feel discomfort. The focus with Mercury is on your mind and ideas; with Venus, on your relationships; with Mars, on your energy and drive; with Jupiter, on your opportunities and expansion; with Saturn, on your responsibilities and goals; with Uranus, on your independence and individuality; with Neptune, on your spirituality; with Pluto, on your power and control; with Chiron, on your wounds and healing; with Black Moon Lilith, on your inner power; and on White Moon Selena, on your path.

So, how can you use the positions of your asteroid Talent to bring out the talents you have?

Unit 6: Asteroid of Your Name

There are many thousands of asteroids out there, and many of them are simply names. Which means, there's likely an asteroid out there of YOUR name! And this asteroid (or asteroids) can have an impact on your and your life.

In your natal chart, the asteroid of your name can almost be like a second Sun, and can be interpreted similarly for sign and house location, and the aspects it makes. You can relate to the energy in a way that may be more subtle when the asteroid of your name is in a different element from your natal Sun.

You can look up asteroids that are for your first, middle, or last names, nicknames, or that sound alike or are spelled similarly. So go check!

Make note: Find the asteroid (or asteroids) of your name(s), and note their sign and house location and major aspects they make in your natal chart.

Asteroid of Your Name in the Elements/Signs

When the asteroid of your name is in a fire sign (**Aries, Leo, Sagittarius**), you can relate to fire energy. You can be optimistic, focused on the good, creative, enthusiastic and driven to pursue what you want for yourself. If your natal Sun is in an earth (Taurus, Virgo, Capricorn) or water (Cancer, Scorpio, Pisces) sign, it might be surprising how much energy you can have at times, and you may be more disciplined with it (earth) or driven by what you feel (water). If your natal Sun is in an air sign (Gemini, Libra, Aquarius), energy may be more mental, but easier to manage. If your natal Sun is in a fire sign as well, then you can seem super fiery, energized and ready to go.

When the asteroid of your name is in an earth sign (**Taurus, Virgo, Capricorn**), you can relate to earth energy. You can be practical, focused, responsible, and hard-working, and stick to whatever you do. If your natal Sun is in a fire sign (Aries, Leo, Sagittarius), you may merge the energies and have energy and drive for what you want, and stick with it once you take action. If your natal Sun is in an air sign (Gemini, Libra, Aquarius), you can stick with your ideas and plans, though may have to watch for being stuck sometimes. If your natal Sun is in a water sign (Cancer, Scorpio, Pisces), the earthy asteroid of your name can help ground some of your emotional energy. If your natal Sun is in an earth sign as well, then you can seem super earthy, grounded, and practical.

When the asteroid of your name is in an air sign (**Gemini, Libra, Aquarius**), you can relate to air energy. You can come up with ideas, are sociable and engaging, and focus more on others. If your natal Sun is in a fire sign (Aries, Leo, Sagittarius), this can give extra mental energy and a positive outlook. If your natal Sun is in an earth sign (Taurus, Virgo, Capricorn), this can ground your mental energy. If your natal Sun is in a water sign (Cancer, Scorpio, Pisces), you may focus on being more expressive with your feelings. If your natal Sun is in an air sign as well, then you can seem super sociable, engaging, and open.

When the asteroid of your name is in a water sign (**Cancer, Scorpio, Pisces**), you can relate to water energy. You can be intuitive, emotionally-driven, supportive, compassionate, and intense. If your natal Sun is in a fire sign (Aries, Leo, Sagittarius), your emotions can motivate you to take action. If your natal Sun is in an earth sign (Taurus, Virgo, Capricorn), you can make practical use of your feelings. If your natal Sun is in an air sign (Gemini, Libra, Aquarius), your head and heart can try to work together. If your natal Sun is in a water sign as well, then you can seem super intuitive, spiritual, nurturing, and magnetic.

Asteroid of Your Name in the Houses

The areas of life ruled by the natal house the asteroid of your name falls in can be more important to you, similarly to where the Sun falls. They may get more of your attention and you may need to make sure you're tending to those matters well. In case you're unfamiliar with the rulerships of the 12 houses, here's a rundown:

1st House: The 1st house is the house of the self, and in prediction, rules the person as a whole, and their physical bodies. Naturally ruled by Aries and Mars.

2nd House: This is the house of money, ruling your disposable income, as well as what you need for security, your self-confidence and self-esteem, what you value, and your value system.

3rd House: This house rules learning on a lower level, so your education before college/university. It also rules the learning you do on your own, informally, what you're interested in, your communication style, and how your mind works.

4th House: This house rules your home and family, as well as your emotions, and your inner foundation, the very core of your being. It's the house at the very bottom of the Zodiac wheel, so it's your base for who you are way deep down.

5th House: This house rules your hobbies, the things you take pleasure in, dating and love (the fun kind, not the serious kind, so it's new love and new relationships), children, and creativity.

6th House: This house is the house of work, health, pets, and daily habits. It's your structure, your routine, your everyday life.

7th House: This is the house of committed relationships and partnerships, showing what you want and need from others, and the kind of people you attract.

8th House: This house rules other people's money, which covers things like taxes, debts, loans, inheritances, and joint finances (both personal and business). It also rules transformations, which covers things like sex, pregnancy, and death.

9th House: This house rules higher education, so college/university. It's your more formal education, and the stuff you learn to expand your mind and view of the world. This house also rules the law and your beliefs.

10th House: This is the house of career, and rules your goals, your life path, and your external foundation. It's the highest part of the chart, showing what you aspire to be.

11th House: This house rules your friends, the groups you belong to, causes you fight for, and your hopes, dreams, and wishes for the future. It's independent and governs change.

12th House: This house rules your spirituality, your subconscious mind, your karma, and endings since it's the last house. This house hides energy so you may not consciously connect to the asteroid of your name, and have to tap into the subconscious.

Asteroid of Your Name Natal Aspects

You can look for aspects that the asteroid of your name makes to your natal chart. Since it is an asteroid though, the orbs will be smaller than when it's aspects between planets (so those can be as wide as 10 degrees, but with asteroids it's usually not more than a few). So you'll want to pay attention to the aspects that are very close.

If the asteroid of your name makes a positive aspect to a planet in your chart that your natal Sun makes a hard aspect to, this can help you try to manage the hard Sun aspect. If it's reverse, the asteroid of your name might bring in some extra obstacles for you to work through.

If the asteroid of your name aspects your natal **Sun**, this may show you right off the bat how easy or challenging it is for you to manifest the asteroid of your name. Squares and oppositions can show that you may feel they're at odds at times, and you have to work on giving them both space. Sextiles and trines can show they work together harmoniously. A conjunction means they're in the same sign, and that simply amplifies the energy of the sign.

Sextiles and trines by the asteroid of your name to your natal planets can show an easier connection to the asteroid. Squares and oppositions to the asteroid of your name can show challenges or blocks to connecting the asteroid to that planet. Conjunctions can

bring a strong connection, tying them together. To the Moon, it focuses on the emotional connection; to Mercury, on the mental connection; to Venus, on interplay with others; to Mars, on motivation and energy; to Jupiter, in pursuit of opportunity and expansion; to Saturn, on responsibilities and lessons; to Uranus, on independence and change; to Neptune, on spiritual connection; to Pluto, on transforming; to Chiron, on healing; to Black Moon Lilith, on empowerment; to White Moon Selena, on your path and growth; conjunct the North Node, on your potential and purpose; and conjunct the South Node, on your baggage.

So, how can you use the asteroid of your name along with your Sun to express your personality fully?

Unit 7: Your Sun-Moon Midpoint

Midpoints in astrology are literally the exact middle between two points. Midpoints show how the two energies come together. Much of the focus is on the midpoints of your planets, and the one that is used most is your Sun-Moon midpoint. The Sun is your true self while the Moon is your emotional self, so the Sun-Moon midpoint is the merging of the two. Hence it being so important!

When you have your Sun and Moon at a hard aspect to one another (square, opposite, quincunx, or a hard minor aspect), the Sun-Moon midpoint is even more important for you. When two planets are at a hard aspect to one another, their midpoint shows how you can reconcile that, how you can make them work in a harmonious way. A way out of the challenge!

When it comes to midpoints, you'll look at the sign and house placement, and for aspects, you keep the orbs tight (usually under 2 degrees, though I find the conjunction can be felt outside of that) and stick to hard aspects: conjunction (0 degrees), square (90 degrees), opposite (180 degrees), semisquare (45 degrees), and sesquiquadrate (135 degrees). The hard aspects aren't considered challenging when it comes to the midpoints; they're just needed because they have more energy.

When you focus on your Sun-Moon midpoint, you can integrate your Sun and Moon, and it feels more natural to you. Use the sign, house, and planets involved to help!

Make note: What is the sign and house location for your Sun-Moon midpoint, and what hard aspects are made to the midpoint in your natal chart?

Sun-Moon Midpoint in the Signs

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in **Aries**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you're being energized, driven toward something, taking action, and taking initiative. Go down new roads, embark on new beginnings, and always remain enthusiastic and excited. Be positive and keep going. Physical exercise and outlets may be beneficial for you and help you feel more centered.

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in **Taurus**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you're slowing things down, carefully making decisions and taking actions, and then sticking with what you start. Be present, in the moment, and get in tune with your body. Being sensual and indulgent can make you feel good, as well as connecting to nature. Grounding yourself constantly can be beneficial for you.

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in **Gemini**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you're using your mind. Focus on your ideas and plans, fill up your schedule to keep busy, and keep the lines of communication open. Engage with others, and engage your mind through learning, teaching, writing, reading, speaking, etc. You can benefit from giving your mind an outlet constantly.

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in **Cancer**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you're connected to your emotions. Tend to your

emotional wants and needs, and maintain emotional stability and security. Give yourself lots of support, have a solid support system, and be nurturing and encouraging with others. Understanding what you feel and why can be beneficial for you.

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in **Leo**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you're being creative. Even if it doesn't seem so on the surface, you can be an incredibly creative person, and that energy needs a focus. If you deny it, that can make you feel much worse. Get in tune with your heart, share the love you feel, and be affectionate and friendly. You can benefit from opening your heart.

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in **Virgo**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you're being productive and efficient. Bring structure and order to your life, create routines and stick to schedules, and take care of the little things. Focus on the details, and use a practical approach. Keep busy with work and chores and tasks and small projects. Take care of your health, and live the healthiest lifestyle you can.

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in **Libra**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you're focusing on your connections with others. You can benefit from your relationships, and need to create solid connections and partnerships based on mutual respect and trust.

Mediating, being diplomatic, and keeping the peace can be good for you, and you may want to strike a balance in your life.

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in **Scorpio**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you're being passionate about something, digging deeper and getting to the core of matters. Find solutions and take a realistic approach. Share with others intimately, and let others in. You may be someone who has to undergo many small transformations throughout your life, or one big one.

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in **Sagittarius**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you're expanding your life in new ways, exploring, and having new experiences. You can benefit from travel to new places, learning lots of new things or about other cultures, and teaching, writing, or speaking. You may be a natural storyteller. Be bold, be daring. Focus on your beliefs, and have a solid connection to them.

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in **Capricorn**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you're focused on your goals and being ambitious. Work hard for what you want, exercise discipline, and be responsible and mature. Do things the right way and for the right reasons. You may benefit from being practical and putting together long-term plans that are realistic for you to follow.

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in **Aquarius**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you're being true to yourself and embracing what makes you different. Be independent, innovative, and inventive. Think outside of the box. Work to help the world, and take up causes you can be passionate about. Create solid friendships. You may benefit from making changes in your life.

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in **Pisces**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you're connecting to your spiritual self. Spirituality can be important for you, and a strong intuition can be helpful. Be compassionate, understanding, and empathic. Use your imagination, and you may benefit from creative or artistic outlets, music or art, or from being around water.

Sun-Moon Midpoint in the Houses

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in the **1st house**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you're starting something new, focused on beginnings, and focused on yourself. Pursue what you want for yourself, and make use of energy and drive. Be open about what you want and what you're working on, sharing your ideas, plans, and actions with the world and not being shy about it.

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in the **2nd house**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you're increasing stability and security in your life. The more stable and secure things are, the better you can feel. Having a healthy connection to money and possessions can also be good for you, as well as healthy confidence and self-worth. Place value in yourself, and live according to your values.

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in the **3rd house**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you're focused on being active, engaged, and using mental energy. Pursue your ideas and plans, and fill up your schedule. You can become involved in your community or neighborhood, and a strong connection to your immediate environment can be beneficial for you.

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in the **4th house**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you have a solid, stable personal and home

life. Make your home and family life as supportive as possible, and make the internal foundation for yourself as strong as possible. When you feel strong internally, you can go far, so tend to internal issues and give yourself that solid foundation.

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in the **5th house**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you're focused on the things you enjoy most and people you love most. Make sure you always have time for fun, for play, for your hobbies, and for your loved ones. Don't let life get too serious! Embrace your inner child and bring joy to your life. You may find that you benefit from being in the spotlight or getting attention as well.

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in the **6th house**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you're focusing on the things that need to be done. Work can be good for you, whether professional work or the work of life, but you likely need a "job" in some way. Pay attention to the details, and do your best work. Managing stress as best as you can may be beneficial for you.

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in the **7th house**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you have healthy relationships that are positive and supportive. Focus on the people in your life, and ask for help when you need it. Create healthy relationships, and keep everyone

on the same page. You may be best when you're right in the middle. Peace and serenity can be good for you, and help with balance.

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in the **8th house**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you're sharing your resources with others, and making use of the resources of others. This is also a big house of transformation, so you may need to undergo a transformation before you can fully merge your Sun and Moon. Dig deeper into yourself and shine light a light on what you hold inside.

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in the **9th house**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you're expanding your mind, learning new things, and sharing your wisdom with others. Be an eternal student and teacher. Get out into the world and see and experience it for yourself. Embrace adventure. You may benefit from getting space, feeling free, and holding strong beliefs.

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in the **10th house**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you're working to achieve something, and feel you're on the right path, going in the right direction, and hit high points. Make your goals a priority, and focus on working hard and smart and doing things the right way. You can benefit from being responsible and maturing.

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in the **11th house**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you work on changes, are independent, and do things in your own way. Embrace the unconventional and push outside of your comfort zone. Open up to lots of people, and keep a wide social circle. Focusing on your dreams and on the future can be beneficial for you.

With your Sun-Moon midpoint in the **12th house**, you can merge your Sun and Moon energy when you're alone, in the background, or behind the scenes and out of the spotlight. Tend to issues of the past, and let go of baggage. Connect to your spiritual self. Since the 12th house is the house of the hidden, you may manifest your Sun-Moon midpoint subconsciously, and have to work on a more conscious connection.

Natal Aspects to the Sun-Moon Midpoint

Remember that with the Sun-Moon midpoint, you only consider the hard aspects (conjunction, semisequare, square, sesquiquadrate, opposition), and that they're not considered challenging, only connected to your Sun-Moon midpoint. And you obviously don't need to consider the Sun or Moon! For further insight, you can consider the sign and house placement of the planet connected to your Sun-Moon midpoint.

When **Mercury** is connected to the Sun-Moon midpoint, this can show your mind is an important part of integrating your Sun and Moon. You may need to always have an outlet for mental energy, work on mental or communication issues, and develop confidence in your ideas and plans. Believe in your mental abilities and skills, and stay engaged and active.

When **Venus** is connected to the Sun-Moon midpoint, this can show your relationships are an important part of integrating your Sun and Moon. You may need to work on having solid relationships, being committed to others, and having equal give-and-take. You may also need to have good self-confidence, and ground yourself.

When **Mars** is connected to the Sun-Moon midpoint, this can show your energy is an important part of integrating your Sun and Moon. You may

need to work on using your energy to your advantage, and using your drive to motivate you to take action. Go for what you want, and take the initiative. Understand what drives you and inspired you to act.

When **Jupiter** is connected to the Sun-Moon midpoint, this can show expansion is an important part of integrating your Sun and Moon. You may need to work on expanding your life, being open to new experiences and opportunities, and seeing the world. Open your mind, and you can benefit from an optimistic outlook and big, bold ideas.

When **Saturn** is connected to the Sun-Moon midpoint, this can show your lessons are an important part of integrating your Sun and Moon. You may need to work on learning the lessons of your Saturn, and can feel that you struggle to merge your Sun and Moon until you do. Once you do, it can be much easier to integrate, and you can feel more secure.

When **Uranus** is connected to the Sun-Moon midpoint, this can show the unconventional is an important part of integrating your Sun and Moon. You may need to work on being independent, unique, and an individual, true to yourself and your differences. Make changes, influence the world, and be conscious of the future.

When **Neptune** is connected to the Sun-Moon midpoint, this can show your spirituality is an important part of integrating your Sun and Moon.

You may need to work on forging a solid connection to your spiritual self, to your intuition, and to your subconscious. You may get easily lost at times, and that solid connection can help you when that happens.

When **Pluto** is connected to the Sun-Moon midpoint, this can show transforming is an important part of integrating your Sun and Moon. You may need to work on a big transformation in your life since Pluto is the transformer, and this may mean forcing yourself to confront inner demons and issues you've hidden away. Once you do, you can feel stronger, more powerful, and more in control.

When **Chiron** is connected to the Sun-Moon midpoint, this can show healing is an important part of integrating your Sun and Moon. You may need to work on healing old wounds and strengthening yourself emotionally and spiritually. Grow and evolve, and you can feel more secure. Embrace your inner healer for yourself.

When **Black Moon Lilith** is connected to the Sun-Moon midpoint, this can show empowering yourself is an important part of integrating your Sun and Moon. You may need to work on learning how to stand up for yourself and speak out when needed, and have confidence in yourself and belief in your opinions to do so.

When **White Moon Selena** is connected to the Sun-Moon midpoint, this can show focusing on your path is an important part of integrating your

Sun and Moon. You may need to work on growing as a person and finding your path in life, and believing in your ability to protect yourself and get through anything.

When the **North Node** is conjunct the Sun-Moon midpoint, this can show that merging your Sun and Moon is an important part of your purpose in this life. You can realize your fullest potential once you integrate your Sun and Moon, and your potential may be found in your Sun-Moon midpoint. When the **South Node** is conjunct the Sun-Moon midpoint, this can show that it's easier for you to merge your Sun and Moon, but that sometimes this energy may be too comfortable and become a crutch. Try to focus on the positives and benefits of your Sun-Moon midpoint without misusing or taking advantage.

Bonus: The 5th house

If you've been around for a while, you may remember the Moon and 5th house lessons from the old Understand Your Heart, Mind, & Body With Astrology Workbook! I wanted to include them here again so this lessons is the 5th house and the next lesson is the Moon.

The 5th house is the house of love, both who we love and what we love, our hobbies, and what brings us joy. These are very important for understanding and tending to our heart, wouldn't you say? To start, you want to look at the sign on the 5th house cusp (the cusp of a house is the very beginning of that house). This is the main way the 5th house energy will be expressed.

Make note: What sign do you have on the 5th house cusp?

Let's start with the fire signs. The fire signs are **Aries, Leo, and Sagittarius**, and are physical and energetic, so if your 5th house cusp is in Aries, Leo, or Sagittarius, you can enjoy physical activities, and ones that require a lot of energy. The fire signs are the most daring signs, so you can also be the adventurous type and feel great doing adventurous things, especially Aries and Sagittarius. This trio also rules sports, so you can enjoy sports, even if you're not athletic. The fire signs are the most

positive signs, so being joyful can be easiest with a fire sign on the 5th house cusp. For Aries, you can feel joy doing things on your own, being independent, being a trailblazer, and doing what you want without having to wait for it to come to you or to get permission. You enjoy taking risks, being a leader instead of a follower, and starting new projects, plans, ideas, and hobbies. For Leo, you can feel joy when you're in the spotlight, entertaining others or yourself, and being the sign of theater and acting, you can enjoy film, television, plays, musicals, or even acting yourself. Leo is also a comedic sign, so you enjoy joking around, laughing, and letting out your inner child. For Sagittarius, you can feel joy when you're exploring the world, other cultures, traveling (especially far and to places you've never been or that seem exotic), and having new experiences. You enjoy expanding your life in new ways, learning about new things, sharing the knowledge you have, debating, telling stories, and being bold.

Next, let's go into the earth signs on the 5th house cusp, which are **Taurus, Virgo, and Capricorn**. An earth sign on the 5th house cusp will subdue your joyful energy to a degree because earth signs are the most grounded of the signs, so you don't get too high or want to show it too much. With the earth signs, you're able to experience your greatest joy when you have stability in your life and a grounded center in yourself. Earth signs are connected to the earth, and so you can find joy in connecting to nature in a physical way. Even if you're not the outdoorsy type, you can have an appreciation for nature. The earth signs also rule

our finances, work, and career, so you can enjoy focusing on any of those. For Taurus, you can enjoy being sensual since Taurus rules the senses, and love rich food, fine wine, beautiful art, great music, and days at the spa. Taurus is the sign that lives in the moment best, so you can enjoy just being in this moment. You can also enjoy spending and splurging on yourself, and financial stability can be important for you to be happy. For Virgo, you can find joy in order, structure, and routine. When your life is chaotic and nothing is in its place, joy can completely escape you. You appreciate the little things, finding joy in the small moments, and can actually enjoy working. This is a good position for a creative profession, and having a job you love is important for you to feel happy. For Capricorn, you can enjoy history, quiet time to yourself, and being around or learning about/from people of importance. You can be fond of your elders (parents, grandparents, mentors, bosses, etc.). This position can be good for a creative career, and having a career that you love can be important to your happiness.

Now we'll move on to the air signs. The air signs are **Gemini, Libra, and Aquarius**, and are signs that are focused on the mind, so having an air sign on your 5th house cusp can show you enjoy mentally-stimulating activities, like reading or writing. Air signs are sociable signs, and enjoy social interaction with other people. With Gemini, you enjoy time spent with the people you're around daily, your neighbors and siblings and the young people in your life, and need some variety with the people that you're around. You enjoy variety in general, and studying different

subjects that interest you. This position can be excellent for a writer. With Libra, you enjoy your time spent with partners, both personal and professional, and the people that you're close to in some way. You enjoy peace and harmony in your relationships, and when you feel you have balance in your life, you can feel free to find your joy. You may be someone who enjoys being with someone more than they enjoy being alone, but you'd prefer someone you see as an equal. With Aquarius, you can enjoy learning as much as you can about whatever interests you. Gemini and Libra can be a little more fleeting with their interests, but you want to stick with it until you learn everything you can, and enjoy the pursuit of knowledge. You enjoy time spent with your friends, in groups, or with the groups you belong to. Aquarius rules charity, so you can enjoy charitable pursuits and making a difference. Aquarius is also the rebel and quirky, so you can enjoy being different, going against social norms, and hobbies that are unusual.

The last group of signs to cover on the 5th house cusp are the water signs, which are **Cancer, Scorpio, and Pisces**. Water signs are focused on emotions, and so you tend to enjoy more serious activities, though you can also enjoy being creative, especially Pisces. With Cancer, you enjoy comfort and familiarity, being in the places you know best and with the people you know best. You can be a homebody, or spend a lot of time in the place you feel is "home" to you. You enjoy comforting activities, like binge-watching your favorite TV show or grabbing some ice cream with your best friend. You can also enjoy home-based

activities, and ones focused on homes themselves, like interior decorating, flipping houses, home improvement projects, etc. With Scorpio, you can enjoy darker subjects like death, having a bit of a fascination with the darker side of life, as well as things that are considered taboo. Scorpio is the sign of the phoenix rising from the ashes, and so you can enjoy transformations, of yourself, of others, even of objects (restoring old homes or objects can be a great hobby of yours). With Pisces, this sign rules music, so you can find great joy in all things music, whether it's listening, playing, singing, teaching, etc. You can also enjoy helping others, spiritual subjects, and being left alone (a little different from actually being alone, more like you just prefer not to be bothered). Water signs also rule the water, so you can really love water, being by or in water, or water-based activities.

Now we'll quickly touch on the **planets in the 5th house**, which will have an impact on the joy in your life. If your Sun is in your 5th house, embracing love and expressing joy is critical to you feeling like yourself and being comfortable in your own skin. You can spend more time on your hobbies and trying to be joyful. If your Moon is in the 5th house, it's important for you emotionally to focus on your hobbies and being joyful so you can feel emotionally secure and at ease. If your Mercury is in the 5th house, freely expressing yourself can bring you great joy, and keeping your head clear is important. If your Venus is in the 5th house, this makes it easier for you to express and find joy. Jupiter in the 5th house is similar, and you have a great capacity for love and joy. Mars in

the 5th house drives you to find joy. Any of these planets in the 5th house greatly increases your creative abilities and potential. Saturn in the 5th house can be the most difficult position because Saturn is restricting and limiting on your ability to feel joy. You usually have to make sure everything in your life is going well and you're doing the right thing in order for you to find real joy. You can find it easier after your first Saturn Return, and can find that you become more joyful with age. Uranus in the 5th house can bring a preference for unusual hobbies and finding joy in unusual things. Neptune in the 5th house can make you artistically inclined. And Pluto in the 5th house can make you very serious about your hobbies, and you can use them to change yourself or life.

Make note: Do you have any planets in the 5th house? How do you feel they express themselves in your life?

Some additional tips: If your 5th house is empty, this shows that you have less blocks to work through in your life to achieve the kind of joy that you want. If your 5th house cusp is at a critical or anaretic degree, which are degrees of critical, crisis energy, this can make joy something that's difficult for you to have in a positive way until you work out whatever blocks you have, or you can go to the other extreme and put

too much emphasis on it so you never take anything seriously. The anaretic degree is 29 degrees of any sign, and the critical degrees are -

0, 13, and 26 of Aries, Cancer, Libra, Capricorn

8-9, 21-22 of Taurus, Leo, Scorpio, Aquarius

4 and 17 of Gemini, Virgo, Sagittarius, Pisces

If your 5th house is intercepted in a sign, meaning completely contained in a sign (so the 5th and 6th house cusps are in the same sign), you can have challenges finding your joy until you work on the blocks from the sign that's swallowed up your 5th house. Conversely, if you have a sign intercepted in the 5th house (so the 6th house cusp sign isn't the sign after the sign on the 5th house cusp, it's the sign after that), you can have hidden potential with your 5th house, extra energy that's blocked off and needs to be unlocked for you to be fully joyful.

Make note if your 5th house is empty, at a critical or anaretic degree, is intercepted in a sign, or has a sign intercepted in it.

So, what have you learned about your heart? What does the sign on the cusp and planets inside (if you have any) of your 5th house say about

what you enjoy in life? In what ways do you already express the joyful energy? In what ways can you bring more joy into your life?

Bonus: The Moon

The Moon rules your emotional self, and what you need to feel emotionally secure and healthy. This is pretty important to your happiness, because if you don't feel right emotionally, you won't ever be happy. The first thing you'll want to look at with your Moon is the sign that your Moon falls in.

Make note: What sign does your Moon fall in?

With your Moon in a fire sign (**Aries, Leo, Sagittarius**), you need to be active in order to feel emotionally secure and stable. Fire signs are full of energy, and always want to be making use of their energy. By being physically active, you can care for your emotional self. The fire signs tend to be more optimistic in general, so it's easier for you to look at the bright side and put yourself in a good mood. You want to be in a good mood. But when you get upset, it usually jumps right to anger, and you can say things in the heat of the moment that you don't really mean. You tend to forget about it quickly, but the person you hurt won't. With an Aries Moon, you want to be independent, on your own, doing what you want, when you want, and putting yourself first. Taking a backseat doesn't feel very good to you. With a Leo Moon, you want to use your

creative energy, be in the spotlight and get praised, and share the warmth in your heart with others. You have a big, big heart. With a Sagittarius Moon, you want to have the freedom to roam, to have new experiences, meet new people, and go to new places, and not feel tied down and held back.

With your Moon in an earth sign (**Taurus, Virgo, Capricorn**), you need to be grounded in order to feel emotionally secure and stable. The earth signs have the most grounded energy, and you want to stay tethered to the ground. You don't want to get too high or too low. This is especially true with a Taurus Moon, and you tend to stay pretty even and calm. The only problem is, when you do get emotional, you can get stuck in that emotion for a while. Some flexibility is required for the earth signs, especially Taurus and Capricorn. Virgo Moon is more flexible, but you're also more easily impacted by stress. Becoming more grounded is more important for your Moon sign. You also want to stay busy and have plenty to do to keep your mind occupied so you don't overthink and stress yourself. Capricorn Moon wants to have a goal to focus on at all times so it can channel its emotional energy into something productive, but has to work on expressing its emotions at times and not avoiding them. You can be a little distant emotionally, so open up. Virgo and Capricorn benefit from having work that they love, and Taurus benefits from having financial stability.

With your Moon in an air sign (**Gemini, Libra, Aquarius**), you need to have a good connection to your mind in order to feel emotionally secure and stable. With the air signs being the signs of the mind, connecting your mind and your emotions is very important. You need to be able to express your thoughts and feelings properly, and not let one get dominated by the other. You tend to analyze and intellectualize your emotions instead of just letting them flow at times, and can let your emotions cloud your judgment at other times. With a Gemini Moon, this is even more important with Gemini being the sign of the mind. You need to be able to express yourself, and you can be quite chatty. With a Libra Moon, you need to feel a connection to the people around you, and feel as though they're there for you when you need them. Striking a balance and having some peace is also important. With an Aquarius Moon, you need to be free to be who you are, however quirky that may be, though you can be the most emotionally-distant of all the Moon signs, so you have to work on allowing yourself to show your feelings when appropriate.

With your Moon in a water sign (**Cancer, Scorpio, Pisces**), your emotions are stronger because the water signs rule emotions, and you have to put in a little more effort to have emotional security and stability because of the extra emotional energy that you have. It's easy for you to get in touch with your emotions, but they can take over at times, so you have to work on making sure you have outlets for your emotional energy. Creativity can be good for the water signs, and having plenty of

emotional support from the people around you, especially Cancer. A Cancer Moon needs to have as much emotional support as they can get, and a strong home and family is important. A Scorpio Moon can sway between extremes emotionally, so you have to work on being more centered. A Pisces Moon needs to feel safe enough to be able to express your feelings, so you often keep them to yourself, not wanting to burden anyone or fall victim to anyone who would use the knowledge against you. Trust in your relationships is key. All of the water signs can benefit from a focus on spirituality, and a strong connection to the soul.

Once you've evaluated the sign that your Moon falls in, you want to investigate the **house** where it's located. With your Moon in the 1st house, you can be very open about your feelings and need to be. You don't want to have to hold back what you're feeling, or lie about it. With the Moon in your 2nd house, having security (both emotionally and financially) is important for you to feel good, and you want a strong connection to your values. With the Moon in your 3rd house, expression is important for you, and you want to communicate openly in order to feel emotionally secure. With the Moon in your 4th house, this is the house the Moon naturally rules, so it's at home here. You can feel more at ease with the emotional expression and energy. With the Moon in your 5th house, you need to focus on the things you enjoy most in life in order to feel emotionally secure, and be free to express yourself creatively. With the Moon in your 6th house, you need some structure

and order in your life to feel emotionally secure, and to do work that emotionally fulfills you. With the Moon in your 7th house, you need to have good relationships with supportive people to feel emotionally secure, and have some balance and peace as well. With the Moon in your 8th house, you need to be allowed to transform yourself and your life periodically in order to feel emotionally secure, and need an outlet for your extreme emotions, especially rage. With the Moon in your 9th house, you need plenty of freedom to do whatever you want in order to feel emotionally secure, and can benefit emotionally from expanding your life and mind. With the Moon in your 10th house, you need to be in a career or on a life path that you find emotionally fulfilling, and succeeding with your goals can bring you emotional security. With the Moon in your 11th house, your friends and the groups that you belong to can bring you emotional security, with them feeling like your family, and you emotionally benefit from taking up causes and feeling as though you're contributing to the world. With the Moon in your 12th house, you can have a hard time expressing yourself emotionally since the 12th house is the house of the hidden, and you have to work on not being so shy, becoming clearer, and having more confidence with your emotional expression.

Make note: Which house is your Moon located? How do you feel it expresses itself for you?

After looking at the signs and houses of your Moon, you can also check out the aspects that your Moon makes to the other 9 planets in your chart. This will color the tone of your Moon, adding in some ease and some difficulty, and bringing some attention elsewhere. Pay special attention to a conjunction or opposition to any planet, as these will have the biggest impact on your emotional self. With a conjunction to a planet, your Moon will take on some of the traits of that planet and the sign it rules. The planetary rulers are:

Sun: Leo

Moon: Cancer

Mercury: Gemini, Virgo

Venus: Taurus, Libra

Mars: Aries

Jupiter: Sagittarius

Saturn: Capricorn

Uranus: Aquarius

Neptune: Pisces

Pluto: Scorpio

Some additional tips: If your Moon is at a critical or anaretic degree, which are degrees of critical, crisis energy, this can make your emotions difficult for you to control and understand. You have blocks in the way that stop you from being able to access your emotional energy in a positive way with ease, so you have to work on removing those blocks or dealing with whatever issues are hampering you. If your Moon is a singleton (the only planet in an element, quality, or house type), this brings extra emphasis to your emotions, and you can have tremendous emotional energy, but struggle with it. You already know the elements; the qualities and house types are:

Qualities

Cardinal: Aries, Cancer, Libra, Capricorn

Fixed: Taurus, Leo, Scorpio, Aquarius

Mutable: Gemini, Virgo, Sagittarius, Pisces

House Types

Angular: 1st, 4th, 7th, 10th houses

Succedent: 2nd, 5th, 8th, 11th houses

Cadent: 3rd, 6th, 9th, 12th houses

Make note if your Moon is at a critical or anaretic degree or is a singleton.

So, what have you learned about your Moon? What does the sign and house position of your natal Moon say about what you need for emotional security? In what ways do you already have this in your life? In what ways do you need to make changes to have a better connection to your emotional self?
